### **Safety precautions**

- Never disassemble or modify your headset for any reason. Doing this may cause the headset to malfunction or become combustible. Bring the headset to an authorised service centre to repair it or replace the battery.
- When using your headset while driving, follow local regulations in the country or region you are in.
- Avoid storage at high temperatures (above 50° C/122° F), such as in a hot vehicle or in direct sunlight, as this can damage performance and reduce battery life.
- Do not expose the headset or any of its supplied parts to rain or other liquids.

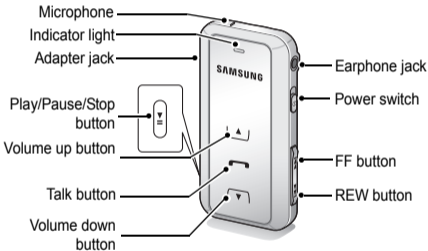


At very high volumes, prolonged listening to the headset can damage your hearing.

# Getting started

This section explains what to remember for the proper use of your Bluetooth headset.

## Your headset overview



Make sure you have the following items with your headset : Travel adapter, User's guide, Earphone, Necklace.

The items supplied with your headset may vary depending on your region.

### **Talk button**

- Press to make or answer a call.
- Press to end a call.

### **Play/Pause/Stop button**

- Press to launch the music player.
- Press to begin or pause playback.
- Press and hold to stop playback.

### **Volume control buttons**

- Press to adjust the volume.

### **REW button**

- Press to skip backward.
- Press and hold to scan backward in a file.

### **FF button**

- Press to skip forward.
- Press and hold to scan forward in a file.

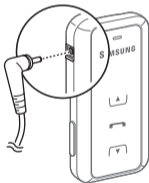
## Power switch

- Slide the switch to turn the headset on or off.

## Charging the headset

This headset has a rechargeable internal battery which is non-removable. Ensure that you fully charge the battery before using the headset for the first time.

- 1 Put the travel adapter into the adapter jack and into a power outlet. The indicator light turns on red.



- 2 Disconnect the travel adapter from the power outlet and the headset when the indicator light changes to blue.



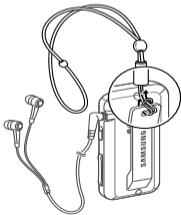
- Use only a Samsung-approved travel adapter. Unauthorised adapters may cause an explosion or damage to the headset.
- The battery will gradually wear out while charging or discharging because it is a consumable part.
- When a call comes in while charging, disconnect your headset from the travel adapter and answer the call.

## When the battery charge gets low

A warning sound beeps and the indicator light flashes red. If you are on a call, transfer the call from the headset to the phone before the headset automatically turns off.

## Wearing on the headset

Plug the supplied earphone into the headset and put the earphone in your ear. Ensure to put the correct (Left, Right) earpiece on each ear. You can connect the supplied necklace. Also, you can attach the headset to your clothes.







# Using your headset

This section explains how to turn the headset on, pair with the phone, and use various functions.





- Activated functions may differ depending on the type of phone.
- Some devices, especially those that are not tested or approved by Bluetooth SIG, may be incompatible with your headset.

## Turning the headset on or off



- Slide the power switch  to turn the headset on. The indicator light sequentially flashes blue, red, purple 2 times.
- Slide the power switch  to turn the headset off.

## Pairing with your Bluetooth phone

Pairing will create a unique and encrypted wireless link between two Bluetooth enabled devices, such as a Bluetooth phone and a Bluetooth headset. To use the headset with other Bluetooth devices, both devices must be paired. When trying to pair the two devices, keep the headset and the phone reasonably close together.

- 1 Enter Pairing mode.
  - Slide the power switch  with pressing and holding  to turn the headset on. The indicator light turns on blue and stays lit after flashing blue, red, and purple twice.
  - If you turn the headset on for the first time, it proceeds into Pairing mode immediately.
- 2 Search for and connect with your phone according to your phone user's guide. (Bluetooth PIN: 0000, 4 zeros).



When the headset and the phone are paired, press  to reconnect via the previously connected Headset Profile or Hands-Free Profile, or press  to reconnect via the Advanced Audio Distribution Profile.

## Using call functions

When you make a call in noisy environments, ensure that the microphone is close to your mouth.

### Making a call

#### Redialling the last number

Press  to redial the last number.

For some phones, pressing the key opens the call log list. Press [▲] or [▼] to scroll through the list, and then press [↩] to dial the selected number.

### **Dialling a number by voice**

Press and hold [↩] to dial a number by voice, and say a name.

### **Answering a call**

Press [↩] to answer a call when you hear incoming call tones.

### **Ending a call**

Press [↩] to end a call.

### **Rejecting a call**

Press and hold [↩] to reject a call when a call comes in.

### **Using options during a call**

You can use the following functions to control your call during a call.

## **Adjusting the volume**

Press [▲] or [▼] to adjust the volume.

## **Muting the microphone**

Press and hold [▲] or [▼] to turn the microphone off so that the person with whom you are speaking cannot hear you. Press and hold [▲] or [▼] again to turn the microphone back on.

## **Transferring a call from the phone to the headset**

Press [↵] to transfer a call from the phone to the headset.

## **Placing a call on hold**

Press and hold [↵] to place the current call on hold.

## **Answering a second call**

Press and hold [↵] to answer a second call when you hear call waiting tones. The first call is placed on hold.

Press [↵] to answer a second call when you hear call waiting tones. The first call is ended.

To switch between the current call and the held call, press and hold [↵].

### Listening to music

- 1 Press [▶||].
- 2 If your phone asks whether to listen to music via the headset, select **Yes** or **OK**.

The music player launches and sound output switches to the headset.



Depend on the type of phone, the headset may read MP3 files only. Ensure that you have the correct file format (\*.mp3).

### Pausing and resuming playback

- 1 Press [▶||] to pause playback.
- 2 Press [▶||] to resume playback.

### Stopping playback

Press and hold [▶||] to stop playback.

## Listening to the previous or next file

Press [**⏮**] to skip backward or [**⏭**] to skip forward.

## Rewinding or fast forwarding

Press and hold [**⏮**] to scan backward or [**⏭**] to scan forward in a file.

## Adjusting the volume

Press [**▲**] or [**▼**] to adjust the volume.




### Answering a call while listening to music

When a call comes in while listening to music, your headset will alert you so that you can answer the call.

- 1 When the headset sounds incoming call tones and the indicator light flashes blue twice, press [**⏮**]. The music stops and you are connected with the caller.
- 2 When you have finished the conversation, press [**⏮**].
- 3 Press [**⏭**] to begin playback again.  
Your phone may automatically begin playback after a call.

## Connecting the headset with other devices

You can connect your headset to the phone and another Bluetooth device that plays music files at the same time.

- 1 Pair the headset with a phone. See page 7.
- 2 If successful, turn the headset off.
- 3 Slide the power switch  with pressing and holding [  ] to turn the headset on. The indicator light turns on blue after flashing blue, red, and purple twice.
- 4 Search for and connect with the device you want according to the device user's guide.
- 5 Press [  ] to connect with the paired phone.
- 6 When the phone and the device are successfully connected with the headset, you can make or answer a call while you are listening to music.

# Appendix

## Frequently asked questions

<b>Will my headset work with laptops, PCs, and PDAs?</b>	Your headset will work with devices that support your headset's Bluetooth version and profiles. For specifications, see page 18.
<b>Will anything cause interference with my conversation when I am using my headset?</b>	Appliances such as cordless phones and wireless networking equipment may cause interference with your conversation, usually adding a crackling noise. To reduce any interference, keep the headset away from other devices that use or produce radio waves.
<b>Will my headset interfere with my car's electronics, radio, or computer?</b>	Your headset produces significantly less power than a typical mobile phone. It also only emits signals that are in compliance with the international Bluetooth standard. Therefore, you should not expect any interference with standard consumer-grade electronics equipment.



<b>Can other Bluetooth phone users hear my conversation?</b>	When you pair your headset to your Bluetooth phone, you are creating a private link between only these two Bluetooth devices. The wireless Bluetooth technology used in your headset is not easily monitored by third parties because Bluetooth wireless signals are significantly lower in radio frequency power than those produced by a typical mobile phone.
<b>The sound is echoing while talking.</b>	Adjust the speaker volume, or move to another area and try again.
<b>Music files are not playing.</b>	Ensure that your music files are compatible with the device you are using.
<b>How do I take care of my headset?</b>	Wipe it with a soft dry cloth.
<b>The headset does not fully charge.</b>	The headset and the travel adapter may not have been connected properly. Separate the headset from the travel adapter, reconnect, and charge the headset.

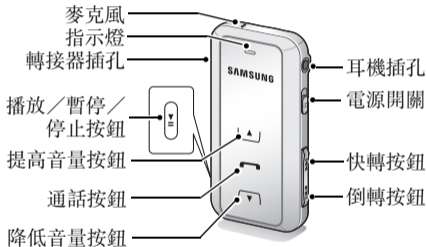

## 耳機相關概述



- 請確認下列耳機配件是否齊全：旅行萬用電源轉接器、使用手冊、耳機以及手機頸帶。  
耳機隨附配件依所處地區而有所差異。

## 按鈕功能

### 通話按鈕

- 按下此按鈕可撥話或接聽來電。
- 按下此按鈕可結束通話。

### 播放／暫停／停止按鈕

- 按下此按鈕可開啓音樂播放器。
- 按下此按鈕可開始或暫停播放。
- 按住此按鈕可停止播放。

### 音量控制鈕

- 按下此按鈕可調整音量。

### 倒轉按鈕

- 按下此按鈕可迴轉。
- 按住此按鈕可倒轉瀏覽檔案。

### 快轉按鈕

- 按下此按鈕可快轉。
- 按住此按鈕可快轉瀏覽檔案。



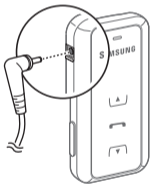
## Ⓞ 電源開關

- 滑動此開關可開啓或關閉耳機電源。

## 耳機充電

本耳機有內建固定式充電電池。第一次使用耳機前請務必讓電池充滿電。

- 1 將電源轉接器插上電源插座後並插入耳機的插孔。  
紅色指示燈亮起。



- 2 待指示燈轉為藍色時，即可拔除電源插座與耳機插孔上的電源轉接器。



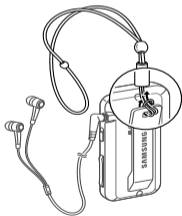
- 僅能使用 Samsung 核可的充電器。未經授權的電源轉接器可能導致爆炸的危險或使耳機受損。

## 當電池電量不足時

## 佩戴耳機

# 使用耳機

本節說明開啓耳機、與手機配對以及使用各種功能的方法。




- 啓用的功能可能依手機類型而有所不同。
- 某些未經 Bluetooth SIG 測試及核准的設備，可能無法與您的手機相容。

## 開／關耳機電源

- 滑動電源開關  可開啓耳機電源。指示燈會接連閃爍藍色、紅色以及紫色兩次。
- 滑動電源開關  可關閉耳機電源。

## 與藍牙手機配對

配對作業即在兩個藍牙啓用裝置（例如您的藍牙手機和藍牙耳機）之間建立唯一且加密的無線連結。要與其他藍牙裝置搭配使用耳機時，需要進行配對。進行配對時，請盡可能縮短耳機與手機間的距離。

- 1 請進入配對模式。
  - 按住 [ ] 並滑動電源開關  可開啓耳機電源。指示燈閃爍藍色、紅色、紫色各兩次後，就會變爲藍色。
  - 若您第一次啓動耳機，耳機便會立即進入配對模式。
- 2 請根據手機使用手冊，搜尋並與手機連接。（藍牙 PIN 碼：0000，4 個 0）



待耳機與手機配對成功時，按下 [ ] 可透過之前所連接的手機模式或免持聽筒重新連接手機；按下 [ ]；可透過進階音源分配模式連接手機。

## 使用通話功能

在吵雜的環境中撥話時，請確認麥克風是否靠近您的嘴巴。

### 撥打電話

#### 重撥上一通電話號碼

按下 [ ] 可重撥上一通電話號碼。

某些手機機型上可按一下此按鈕，即開啓通話記錄清單。按下 [ ] 或 [ ] 可捲動清單，按下 [ ] 可撥打所選電話號碼。

## 聲控撥號

按住 [ ] 可用語音撥號，對著麥克風說出姓名。

## 接聽來電

聽到來電鈴聲時，請按下 [ ] 接聽來電。

## 結束通話

按下 [ ] 可結束通話。

## 拒接來電

按住 [ ] 可拒絕接聽來電。

## 在通話中使用選項

通話中您可使用以下功能控制通話。

## 調整音量

按下 [▲] 或 [▼] 可調整音量。

## 麥克風靜音

按住 [▲] 或 [▼] 麥克風關閉，使通話對方無法聽到您的聲音。再次按住 [▲] 或 [▼] 取消麥克風靜音。

## 將通話從手機轉接至耳機

按下 [📞] 可將通話從手機轉接至耳機。

## 保留通話

按住 [📞] 保留目前的通話。

## 接聽第二通來電

當您聽到待接通話時，按住 [📞] 可接聽第二通來電。保留第一通電話。

當您聽到待接通話時，按下 [📞] 可接聽第二通來電。結束第一通來電。

若要切換目前通話與保留的通話，按住 [📞]。

## 使用音樂控制功能

### 聆聽音樂

- 1 按下 [▶||]。
- 2 如果您的手機詢問您是否透過耳機聆聽音樂，選擇**是**或**確定**。  
啓動音樂播放器，並將聲音輸出切換至耳機。

某些類型的手機，可能只能讀取 MP3 檔案。請確認您音樂檔案的格式正確 (\*.mp3)。

### 暫停或繼續播放音樂

- 1 按下 [▶||] 暫停播放音樂。
- 2 按下 [▶||] 繼續播放音樂。

### 停止播放

按住 [▶||] 以停止播放音樂。

### 聆聽上一個／下一個檔案

按下 [◀◀] 跳至前一個檔案或 [▶▶] 跳至後一個檔案。

## 倒帶或快轉

按住 [⏮] 倒轉瀏覽或 [⏭] 快轉瀏覽檔案。

## 調整音量

按下 [▲] 或 [▼] 調整音量。

### 聽音樂時接聽來電




聽音樂時若有來電，耳機將提醒您接聽電話。

- 1 耳機響起來電鈴聲時，且藍色指示燈閃爍 2 次，按下 [⏸]。音樂停止，並將您連接給來電者。
- 2 結束通話時，按下 [⏸]。
- 3 按下 [⏭] 開始再次播放音樂。  
您的手機可能於通話結束後，自動開始播放音樂。



## 以其他裝置連接耳機

您可以連接您的耳機至手機與另一個同時播放音樂檔案的藍牙裝置。

- 1 將耳機配對手機。請參閱第 25 頁。
- 2 若成功，請關閉耳機電源。
- 3 按住 [  ] 滑動電源開關  可開啓耳機電源。指示燈閃爍藍色、紅色、紫色各兩次後，就會變為藍色。
- 4 根據裝置的使用手冊，搜尋並連接您想要的裝置。
- 5 按下 [  ] 以連接至配對的手機。
- 6 手機與裝置成功連接耳機時，便可在聽音樂時，撥話或接聽來電。

# 附錄

## 常見問題

**我的筆記型電腦、電腦以及 PDA 可以搭配此耳機嗎？**

任何支援耳機藍牙版本以及設定檔的設備皆可搭配本耳機使用。如需規格的詳細資訊，請參閱第 36 頁。

**使用耳機是否會對通話產生干擾？**

無線電話與無線網路設備等裝置皆可能會對通話產生干擾，通常是出現撕裂聲的雜音。若要降低干擾，請在使用或產生無線電波的裝置與耳機之間保持一定距離。

**耳機是否會干擾汽車的電子系統、收音機或電腦？**

比起一般的行動電話，耳機的功率極低。耳機僅會發射符合國際藍牙標準的訊號。因此不會對標準的消費者電子設備產生干擾。

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其他藍牙手機使用者是否能夠收聽我的通話？	將耳機與藍牙手機配對時，會在兩個藍牙裝置之間建立機密連結。耳機採用的無線藍牙技術較不易受到第三方監控，因為與一般的行動電話相比，藍牙無線訊號的無線電頻率功率較低。
通話時聲音出現回音。	調整喇叭音量，或於其他區域再行通話。
無法播放音樂檔案。	確認音樂檔案與裝置是否相容。
如何保養耳機？	使用柔軟乾布擦拭即可。
耳機未完全充電。	旅行充電器未正確插入耳機。請從耳機拔下旅行充電器，然後重新插上耳機並充電。
