


The following illustrations represent the precautions to be taken when using and moving your television.




Do NOT expose the television to extreme temperature conditions (below 5°C and above 35°C) or to extreme humidity conditions (less than 10% and more than 75%).



If the television is broken, do not try to repair it yourself. Contact qualified service personnel.




Do NOT expose the television to direct sunlight.




During a storm conditions (especially when there is lightning) unplug the television from the mains socket and aerial.




Do NOT expose the television to any liquids.

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

Using the Buttons on the Front Panel

If your remote control no longer works or you have lost it, you can use the controls on the front panel of the television to:


- Switch on the television when it is in Standby mode and select channels (▼C/P. Ů▲)
- ◆ Access the main menu (MENU)
- ♦ Adjust the volume (→ +)

Buttons on the front panel have the same function as corresponding buttons on the remote control.

The actual configuration on your TV may be different, depending on your model.



Rear of TV



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

Inserting the Batteries in the Remote Control








You must insert or replace the batteries in the remote control when you :

- Purchase the television.
- Find that the remote control is no longer operating correctly.
- 1 Remove the cover of the remote control by pressing the symbol (PRES) and pulling the cover in the direction of the arrow.
- 2 Insert batteries, taking care to respect the polarities:
 - + on the battery with + on the remote control
 on the battery with on the remote control
- **3** Replace the cover by pushing it in the direction of the arrow.

Connecting the Aerial (or Cable Television Network)



To view television channels correctly, a signal must be received by the set from one of the following sources:


- An outdoor aerial
- A cable television network

Plug the aerial or cable network input cable to the 75Ω coaxial socket on the rear of the television.

Switching Your Television On and Off

The mains lead is attached to the rear of the television.

- If you have purchased this television in the United Kingdom, refer to rear cover for further instructions on plug wiring.
- Plug the mains lead into an appropriate socket.
 The main voltage is indicated on the rear of the TV set and the frequency is 50 or 60Hz.
- Press the "① " (ON/OFF) button on the front of the television.
 <u>Result</u>: The Standby indicator lights up on the front panel.
- **3** Press the **POWER** button on the remote control to switch the television on.
 - <u>Result</u>: The programme that you were watching last is reselected automatically.
- **4** To switch your television off, press the "①" (ON/OFF) button again on the front of the television.



Placing Your Television in Standby mode

Your television can be placed in Standby mode, in order to reduce:

- Power consumption
- Wear of the cathode ray tube

The Standby mode can be useful when you wish to interrupt viewing temporarily (during a meal, for example).

The television is placed automatically in Standby mode when you turn it on.

- 1 Press the **POWER** (b) button on the remote control. <u>Result:</u> The screen is turned off and the Standby indicator on the front of the television lights up.
- 2 To switch the screen back on, simply press the **POWER** button again on the remote control.
- Do not leave your television in standby mode for long periods of time (when you are away on holiday, for example). In this case, you should switch it off completely.

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When the television is initially powered ON, three basic customer settings proceed automatically and subsequently: setting the language, channel and clock.

- 1 If the television is in Standby mode (red light visible on the television front panel), press the **POWER** () button on the remote control.
 - <u>Result:</u> The message "Plug & Play" is displayed. It flickers for a little while and then the "Language" menu is automatically displayed.
- 2 Press the ▲ or ▼ button to select required language. Press the MENU button to enter the language, and then the message "Ant. Input Check" is displayed.
 - If any language is not selected on the "Language" menu, the "Language" menu will be displayed about 30 seconds later.
- **3** Make sure that the antenna is connected to the TV. And then press the + or button to store the channels (refer to "Storing the Channels Automatically" on page 12).
 - Result: The horizontal bar is displayed, and then channels are stored in an order which reflects their positions in the frequency range.
- **4** When searching and storing is complete, the "Time" menu is displayed.
- 5 Press the + or button to move to the hour or minute. Set the hour or minute by pressing the ▲ or ▼ button (refer to "Setting and Displaying the Current Time" on page 23).
- 6 When you have finished, press the **MENU** button.
 - <u>Result:</u> The message "Enjoy Your Watching" is displayed, and then the channel which has been stored will be activated.
- 7 If you want to reset this feature...
 - 1 Press the **MENU** button.
 - 2 Press the ▲ or ▼ button to select the "Function", and then press the + or − button.
 - 3 Select the "Plug & Play" by pressing the ▲ or ▼ button, and then press the + or button.
 - Result: The message "Plug & Play" is displayed.

Choosing Your Language

When you start using your television for the first time, you must select the language which will be used for displaying menus and indications.

1	Press the MENU button.
2	Press the \blacktriangle or \blacktriangledown button to select the "Function".
3	Press the + or - button to select the "Language".
4	Select a particular language by pressing the \blacktriangle or \blacktriangledown button repeatedly.
5	When you have finished, press the TV button or, press the

MENU button repeatedly to return to normal viewing.











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Storing the Channels Automatically








You can scan the frequency ranges available on your television and in your country and store all the channels found automatically.

The channels are stored in the order in which they appear in the frequency bands. It is possible that the automatically allocated numbers may not correspond to those by which you wish to identify the channels. If this is the case, refer to "Sorting the Stored Channels" on page 16.

Selecting a Channel Numbered Ten or Over



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When using the numeric buttons to select a channel stored at programme position ten or higher, follow the instructions below.

1 Press the -/-- button.

<u>Result:</u> The "---" symbol is displayed.

2 Enter the two-digit channel number.

Example: To select channel 42, press 4, followed by 2.



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Skipping Unwanted Channels



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You can exclude the channels of your choice from the channel scan operation. When you scan through the stored channels, those you have chosen to skip are not displayed.

All channels that you do not specifically choose to skip are displayed during scanning.

1	Press the MENU button.
2	Press the \blacktriangle or \blacktriangledown button to select the "Channel" and press the + or – button.
3	Press the \blacktriangle or \bigtriangledown button to select the "Add/Erase" and press the + or – button.

Fine tuning Channel Reception

If the reception is clear, you do not have to fine-tune the channel, as this is done automatically during the search and store operation. If however the signal is weak or distorted, you may have to finetune the channel manually.



- ➤ The television has an "automatic degaussing" system that is activated if magnetic interference is present. To degauss the television screen, switch power off by pressing the "①" (ON/OFF) button on the front panel (refer to "Automatic Degaussing to Remove Color Patches" on page 31).
- If you make any changes to the "Adjust" settings, the picture standard is automatically switched to "Custom".

Adjusting the Volume

You can adjust the volume by pressing the + or – button on the remote control.

- Press the + button to increase the volume (cursor moves to the right)
 Press the button to decrease the volume (cursor moves to the left)
 - \succ The volume setting is retained:
 - When you switch the television to standby mode
 - When you switch the television off using the "①" (ON/OFF) button on the front panel
 - If there is a power failure.



Changing the Sound Standard (depending on the model)

You can select the type of special sound effect to be used when watching a given broadcast. The following sound effects are available in the order given:

- Custom, Standard, Music, Movie, Speech.
- **1** Press the **MENU** button.
- Press the ▲ or ▼ button to select the "Sound" and press the + or − button.
 - Result: The "Mode" menu is selected.
- **3** Select to satisfy your preference by pressing the **+** or **-** button.
- 4 When you have been finished, press the TV button or, press the MENU button repeatedly to return to normal viewing.
- You can select the required sound effect by simply pressing the "S.STD" (Sound standard) button on the remote control.







Switching the Sound Off Temporarily



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You can switch the sound off temporarily, for example you may wish to answer the telephone.

- 1 Press the MUTE 𝖧 button. <u>Result:</u> The sound is switched off and "⊠" is displayed.
- 2 When you wish to turn the sound back on at the same volume as before, press the MUTE ¤X button again (or either of the volume buttons).

Extra Sound Settings (depending on the model)

The following sound settings can be adjusted to suit your personal preferences.

♦ Auto Volume

Each broadcasting station has its own signal conditions, and so it is not easy for you to adjust the volume every time the channel is changed. "Auto Volume" lets you automatically adjust the volume of the desired channel by lowering the sound output when the modulation signal is high or by raising the sound output when the modulation signal is low.

Melody

You can hear clear melody sound when the TV is powered ON or OFF.

Pseudo Stereo

"Pseudo Stereo" converts a monaural sound signal into two identical left and right channels. Once the "Pseudo Stereo" is set to "On" or "Off", the setting applies to the sound effects such as Standard, Music, Movie and Speech.


Turbo Sound

You can enjoy more magnificent and dynamic sound when watching music, movie or other channel. "Turbo Sound" suitably emphasizes both higher and lower bands of sound (and includes other effects).

Selecting the Sound Mode (depending on the model)



The "S.MODE I-II" button displays/controls the processing and output of the audio signal. When power is switched ON, the mode is automatically preset to either "Dual-I" or "STEREO", depending on the current transmission.

If the receiving conditions deteriorate, listening will be easier if the mode is set to the "MONO" position using the S.MODE I-II button.

 If the stereo signal is weak (or if intermittent Stereo-Mono) and automatic switching occurs, then switch to the "MONO" mode.

 When receiving mono sound in the AV mode, connect to the "L" input jack on the panels. If the mono sound comes out only from the left speaker, then press the S.MODE I-II button.

Automatic Degaussing to Remove Color Patches

A degaussing coil is mounted around the picture tube, so you do not normally need to degauss the television manually.

If you move the television to a different position and color patches appear on the screen, you must:

- ◆ Switch the television off by pressing the " ① " (ON/OFF) button on the front panel
- Unplug the television from the wall socket
- Leave the television power-off (stand-by) for about 30 minutes so that the automatic degauss function can be activated, and then press the POWER () button on the remote control.

■ If your television will be left unattended, press the "①" (ON/OFF) button to turn your television off.

Troubleshooting: Before Contacting Service Personnel

Before contacting Samsung after-sales service, perform the following simple checks.

If you cannot solve the problem using the instructions below, note the model and serial number of the television and contact your local dealer.

No sound or picture	 Check that the mains lead has been connected to a wall socket. Check that you have pressed the "①" (ON/OFF) button. Check the picture contrast and brightness settings. Check the volume.

No picture or black and white picture	 Adjust the colour settings. Check that the broadcast system selected is correct.
Sound and picture interference	 Try to identify the electrical appliance that is affecting the television and move it further away. Plug your television into a different mains socket.
Blurred or snowy picture, distorted sound	 Check the direction, location and connections of your aerial. This interference is often due to the use of an indoor aerial.
Remote control malfunctions	 Replace the remote control batteries. Clean the upper edge of the remote control (transmission window). Check the battery terminals.
