Proper care and use of your mobile device

Keep vour device dry

- Humidity and all types of liquids may damage device parts or electronic circuits.
- When wet, remove the battery without turning on your device, Dry your device with a towel and take it to a service centre
- Liquids will change the colour of the label that indicates water damage inside the device. Water damage to your device can void your manufacturer's warranty.

Do not use or store your device in dusty, dirty areas Dust can cause your device to malfunction

Do not store your device on slopes

If your device falls, it can be damaged.

Do not store your device in hot or cold areas. Use your device at -20 $^{\circ}\text{C}$ to 50 $^{\circ}\text{C}$

Set and use alarms

To set a new alarm 1. In Menu mode, select Alarms.

To stop an alarm

The snooze feature sets the phone to repeat the alarm after a specified length of time. To set the length of time for the snooze feature, press <0ptions> \rightarrow Settings \rightarrow Spooze Duration
