Automatic Degaussing to Remove Color Patches

A degaussing coil is mounted around the picture tube ,so you do not normally need to degauss the television manually.

If you move the television to a different positionand color patches appear on the screen, you must:

- ◆ Switch the television off by pressing the "POWER ()" (ON/OFF) button on the front
- Unplug the television from the wall socket.
- Leave the television power-off (stand-by) for about 30 minutes so that the automatic degauss function can be activated, and then press the "POWER()" button on the remote

Note: If your television will be left unattended, press the "POWER () " (ON/OFF) button to turn your television off.
