Executive Summary

The User Guide for Installer of opaque thermal insulation systems is addressed to the workforce in the construction sector and to the construction companies and it contains a brief based on the qualification scheme content for stimulating participation in the new developed scheme for building thermal insulators. The user guide is structured as it follows:

- The main benefits or what's in it for the worker if he chooses qualification: a certification of his skills and professional development, stability and flexibility at work, more protected, a better salary, easily promoted, to raise the quality of his work, to adapt to new technologies, to contribute to energy performance of buildings etc.
- The main competences obtained after qualification: for the initiation certificate and for the qualification certificate
- A list of the suitable occupations for the qualified worker in another occupation of the same level to be qualified for Installer of opaque thermal insulation systems (specialization or perfection course): sound proofer, repellent insulator, mason-plasterer, head of underground, art team works, tiller, fitter of interior and exterior plywood, plasterer, painter, ornamental plasterer, facade cleaner.
- The main conditions of access (the registration file) and steps to follow for participation in the training programs.
- The activities to be learned in the training course, for better understanding of the training content: permanent on site activities, the substrate preparation activities, supporting structure installation, the installation of thermal insulation layer, the hardening of thermal insulation activities, the finishing activities of the opaque thermal insulation system.
- Some facts the worker has to know about the employer's obligation regarding his training: costs, study holiday etc.
