HOW TO REGISTER, PAY AND LOG IN TO THE COURSE

Step 1: Check your computer compatibility

Before proceeding with the course registration, ensure your computer meets the system requirements. This process can be completed in four easy steps.



Step 2: Proceed with Registration

Once you have updated your computer and it meets the minimum system requirements, click on Continue Registration. Then, click on Register for Introduction to Post Traumatic Stress Disorder. The registration form will appear.
