Quesnel Rod and Gun Range Operating Instructions

General

These Range Operating instructions cover the use of the range facility operated by the Quesnel Rod and Gun Club. All Range Officers (RO) and range users are required to read and sign these Range Operating Instructions every year when memberships are purchased. Requests for exemptions from any of the provisions given in these Range Operating Instructions shall be submitted in writing to the Board of Directors for approval.

Indoor Range

Description – 25m Hand-gun / Rimfire Rifle Range
Firing Distance Max – 25m
Number of Firing Points - 14
Approved Firearms-Hand-guns / Rifle All Action Types. No Center- Fire Rifles / Shotguns Allowed
Maximum Approved Calibres -22LR - 9mm Parabellum Template. Power factor of 200 or less.
Approved Targets – Paper Only

Approved Ammunition - FMJ, Soft- Point and Lead

Personnel

The RSO (Range Safety Officer) has complete authority to conduct authorized shooting practices and matches on the range property. RSO's have the responsibility to supervise all personnel (shooting and non – shooting) present on the property and reserve the right to have members and/or non- members removed at their discretion. Signs with the duties of a Range Officer are posted on each range.

All Quesnel Rod and Gun Members will visibly display their membership card either on a lanyard around the neck, or in a clear clip on pocket card holder. Lanyards and card holders are made available by Quesnel Rod & Gun Club.

The main gate must be locked at all times. Members must close and lock the gate behind them.

Guests and Spectators

Guests (Children and Adults) and pets are the responsibility of the Quesnel Rod and Gun Club Member who they came with and must remain under the members control at all times . Pets are to be on a leash during active shooting times. Spectators are the responsibility of the RSO. The RSO must take personal responsibility for them or delegate that responsibility to Quesnel Rod and Gun Club Member. Members may bring guests to shoot on the range. There is a \$ 10 dollar insurance fee (\$5 for JR/SR guests). The Quesnel Rod and Gun Club member and their guest must print their name in the guest book, date it and the guest must sign in and out. Members can turn in the insurance fee at a general meeting or to a Director. The guest may only use the range a max of 3 times a year. The member is responsible for turning in the insurance fee. If these procedures are not followed, the club insurance is null and void. The member is liable for any damage or injury caused by their guest.

Range Operations

<u>Flags</u>: Red Range Flags must be flown when the range is in use. Red Firing Line Flag must be flown when range is active. Green Firing Line Flag must be flown when firing has ceased. NO HANDLING OF FIREARMS IS PERMITED WHEN THE GREEN FIRING LINE FLAG IS FLOWN. THE LAST PERSON TO LEAVE, MUST ENSURE THAT THE RED FIRING LINE FLAG IS LEFT UP.

<u>Targets</u>: Only Quesnel Rod and Gun Club Approved Targets to be used on club property. Indoor Range - Paper Targets Only. Trap Range – Frangible Clay Skeet Targets. Handgun /Rifle Ranges- Paper Targets and Reactive Steel Targets. <u>At no time</u> can, glass, popcans, plastic containers or similar targets to be used on club property.

<u>Backsplash</u>: Backsplash is defined as fragmented bullet or target materials, or ground debris, thrown back towards the shooter as a result of bullet or projectile impact. Therefore the Minimum Engagement Distances for Backsplash are:

Rim-Fire Handgun/Rifle	10 m +	10 m +
Center – Fire Handgun	10 m +	10 m +
Center –Fire Rifle	100 m +	100 m +

Log Book: All range users must sign in before using the range.

Ammunition: All spent ammunition cases or shotgun hulls must be collected and disposed of in containers provided or removed from the range. The use of incendiary, explosive, tracer or armour piercing bullets are prohibited. Only authorized calibres and types of ammunition may be used on any range. The detonation of explosive devices is prohibited on club property. Shotgun Slugs to be shot on the 500 Meter Range Only.

<u>Firing Guidelines</u>: When two or more shooters are on the firing line one will be the RSO. Shooters with loaded firearms will be under the RSO direction at all times. Loaded firearms must not be left unattended. Load the firearm on the shooting line and only when the RSO gives the command to do so.

Firearm Safety Area: All ranges have a safety area. No loaded firearms or ammunition is allowed in the safety area.

Hunting: Hunting is prohibited on club property.

Full Auto Firearms: The use of Full Auto Firearms is prohibited on club property.

Range Safety Area: Each range has a safety or danger area designed for specific firearms and calibres. These areas are out of bound areas designed to contain overshoot and ricocheting bullets. Every reasonable effort shall be extended by the RSO to ensure that the safety area does not have people in it during range operations.

<u>Range Closure</u>: Due to the range configuration, range closures must be in effect during the operation of certain ranges. These closures are as follows – 500m, 100m and 25m ranges, when the North Steel Pistol Bay is in use.

<u>Garbage</u>: All garbage is to be picked up including empty shell cases, shotgun hulls and paper targets and shot up cardboard from target stands and put in garbage bins or taken home.

<u>Handgun Holsters:</u> Individual club members, who wish to deploy a handgun from a holster during open shooting time, may only do so while on the 25 Meter Range, in one of the Three East Pistol Bays.

Only those members who have completed an IPSC Course, SASS Training, STEEL CHALLENGE Training, a Police or Military Holster Training Program, or the Quesnel Rod and Gun Club Holster Course can use Holsters on the Indoor range, or on the Three East Pistol Range or 25m Range.

Quesnel Rod and Gun Club will offer a General Handgun Holster handling course for any member, wishing to use a holster to deploy a handgun on designated ranges during general member use hours of operation.

<u>Alcohol/ Drug:</u> Any person deemed by any of the Executive, a Director or the RSO to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be allowed to handle firearms or shoot.

<u>Spectators</u>: Spectators will follow all directions given to them by the RSO. Spectators must remain behind any active firing line.

<u>Hearing and Eye Protection</u>: Hearing and Eye protection for all shooters and spectators on or near proximity to an active firing line is mandatory.

<u>Smoking</u>: Smoking is not permitted on any firing line. Smoking is permitted in the parking lots of all ranges. All smoking materials are to be disposed of in the containers provided.
