

- Windows® 2000/XP/Vista/7


NOTE:







PC Camera Introduction




Setup PC Camera

Provide the option of a Webcam for your desktop, notebook or LCD monitor by using the adjustable stand.




Driver Installation


1. Turn on the computer and insert the CD installation disc into your CD-ROM drive. Select and click “Driver “.



2. Click “OK” to continue.



3. Click “Finish” to complete the installation.



4. If the operating system is Window Vista, the “Found New Hardware” message will pop-up once the web cam is connected to the computer. Please choose “Locate and install driver software (recommended)” from the list.

ArcSoft WebCam Companion 3.0


1. Turn on the computer and insert the CD installation disc into your CD-ROM drive. Select and click “ArcSoft WebCam Companion 3.0”.

3. Click “Next”.




4. Click “Yes”.

Snapshot by ArcSoft WebCam Companion 3.0

1. Click on the “WebCam Companion 3.0”
icon on the desktop.



2. Click “Capture”.



3. Click “640x480 (VGA) Setting”
to select the suitable resolution.



4. Click “Capture” for capture image and the picture is saved. Click “Record Video” to start recording. Click it again to stop.



5. The captured picture and video file will be saved in :
“My Documents \ WebCam Media”.



6. Press the “Delete” icon to delete the selected picture or video.


1. Turn on the computer and insert the CD installation disc into your CD-ROM drive. Select and click “ArcSoft Magic-i”.



2. Choose Setup Language.









1. Insert the two plugs to the computer sound card at the back and to their corresponding symbols. Normally, pink for microphone and green for the speaker.
2. Adjust the headset to fit left or right and clip on to your ear.
3. Adjust the microphone close to your mouth. You are ready to start.
