

GLOCHARGER OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Connect the GloCharger's alligator clips to a 12V DC power source (red to positive [+], black to negative [-]). The yellow "POWER" LED will light when a good power connection has been made. CAUTION: When using an automotive battery as a power source, do NOT run the engine as this may permanently damage your GloCharger or glow starter.
- 2. Lock your glow starter onto the charge jack inside the faceplate of the GloCharger. The GloCharger will be in trickle mode after connection to a glow starter.
- 3. Press the button marked "PUSH". The red "ON" LEO will light, indicating fast charge has begun
- 4. Fast charge will stop automatically in 15-20 minutes. The red "ON" LED will go out and trickle charge will resume until your glow- starter or DC power is removed,
- 5. The GloCharger is not designed to full charge your glow starter in a single charge period. To fully charge your glow starter, use the overnight charger supplied with your glow starter or leave it connected to the GloCharger in trickle mode overnight
