1. Parts included with your Vital Force MKIII package

(Please check that all parts are included within the packaging)

a. Vital Force MKIII



- b. Lid x 2
- c. Power Adapter charger

2. Setting up your Vital Force MKIII

- a. Carefully remove the Vital Force MKIII from its packaging
- b. Ensure the power switch is selected to the 'OFF / CHARGE' position
- c. Turn on the power switch and the orange 'POWER ON' LED will light (if the orange 'POWER ON' LED does not light then go to the charging step see below)
- d. Press the 'START' button (if the green 'RUNNING / BATTERY OK' LED does not light then go to the charging step see below)
- e. Your new Vital Force MKIII is now ready for use simply switch the unit off to cancel the 'RUNNING' process

3. Charging the Vital Force MKIII (note 1)

- a. Select the 'Power Switch' to the 'OFF / CHARGE' position
- b. Plug the Power Adapter (note 2) into the 'CHARGER' socket on the rear panel
- c. Allow approximately 24 hours to fully charge

*note 1: Charging is only recommended when the battery will no longer power the unit, i.e. when the 'BATTERY OK' light does not light when the 'START' button is depressed. Avoid "topping up" the battery for best results

*note 2: Using any other adapter other than the unit supplied may void your warranty

4. Controls, Indicators and connections

m.	'CHARGER' Socket	Plug the supplied plug pack into here to charge the unit (do not use any other power adapter)	p.	Input Plate	The source should be placed here			
n.	'INPUT' BNC socket	Plug any external source into here for convenience	q.	Output Chamber (Small)	The source will be copied to the item placed in here			
0.	'OUTPUT' Socket	Plug an external probe into here for potentising objects that cannot fit into the canisters	r.	Output Chamber (Large)	The source will be copied to the item placed in here (use for large vials)			

5. Instructions for 'Copying' substances

- a. Turn the power switch to the 'ON' position
- b. Select the 'TIME LOG' to the appropriate length of time
- c. Ensure the 'POTENTISE / INVERT' switch is set to the 'POTENTISE' setting*
 * See section 7 for invert function
- d. Set the 'MULTIPLIER' dial to the 'COPY' position
- e. Set the 'POTENCY x100' dial to the 'COPY' position (Note 1)
- f. Press the 'START' button and leave all items in place until the 'RUNNING LED' has turned off
- * Note 1: With the 'MULTIPLIER' and 'POTENCY x100' dials set to 'COPY' the other dials will have no effect

6. Instructions for 'Potentising' substances

- a. Turn the power switch to the '**ON**' position
- b. Select the 'TIME LOG' to the appropriate length of time
- c. Ensure the 'POTENTISE / INVERT' switch is set to the 'POTENTISE' setting*
 * See section 7 for invert function
- d. Set the 'MULTIPLIER' dial to the appropriate position
- e. Set the '**POTENCY**' dials to indicate the appropriate position for the potency required in Units (x1), 10's(x10) and 100's(x100).
- f. Press the 'START' button and leave all items in place until the 'RUNNING LED' has turned off

7. Using the 'INVERT' function

The 'INVERT' function is simply to invert the substance. To do this set the 'INVERT / POTENTISE' switch to the 'INVERT' position. Follow the other instructions as normal.
