

Latvian IT Unicode — Operating instructions



There are two dead keys, the apostrophe and tilde keys marked 1 and 2 in the illustration above. After pressing a dead key another key has to be pressed.

Latvian long and soft letters are entered with the help of the single apostrophe key marked 1 above and THEN the letter key.

Press ‘ then **a** to enter **ā**

Latvian letters provided with apostrophe key ‘ (key 1):

Characters provided with reverse apostrophe ` (key 2):

German letters provided with double quote “ (key 3):

To enter an apostrophe press the ‘ key and then the space bar.
