

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS HEATERS

READ FIRST

Preliminary: Check that the wall thermostat is turned off To RESTART your heater: - Open duct register in all rooms. Turn on gas Supply meter and Power point.

Electronic Ignition Models without Pilot.

Models P12: P20: P25: P35 EA & ESS and J60El: J90 El J120 El: J150 El: EX/RT 90-225 incl

Turn the gas control valve to the **ON** position. (If fitted to your unit)

- 1. Turn the thermostat to the **OFF** position.
- 2. Turn the 240V AC power on, at power point, or three phase
- 3. Turn the thermostat to a setting **above** room temperature.
 - * Your Stadt heater should automatically turn on after approx 2 minutes

NOTE:

If the unit fails to light, remove the gas control access panel and observe the red indicator light. If the light is flashing, turn the **thermostat OFF** and depress the **reset** button for five seconds. The red indicator light will then stop flashing five seconds after the reset is released. Follow the lighting procedure to relight the unit.

If the system still fails to light, refer to the Service instructions, which are located on the unit, or contact ,on (03) 9800 2409.

Electronic Ignition Models with Pilot

Models J60: J90: J120: J150: J180: J225 S60: S90: S120: S150: S180: S225 EX/RT 90-225 incl

- 1. Turn the gas control valve to the **ON** position. (If fitted to your unit)
- 2. Turn the thermostat to the **OFF** position.
- 3. Turn the 240V AC power on, at power point
- 4. Turn the thermostat to a setting **above** room temperature.
 - * Your Stadt heater should automatically turn on after approx 2 minutes

NOTE:

If the unit fails to light. Repeat steps 2, 3, and 4, above. If the system still fails to light, refer to the Service instructions, which are located on the unit, or contact (03) 98002409.
