- Do not place heavy objects on top of the Bluetooth Speaker
- Keep away from extreme temperatures and store in areas away from dust and humidity
- Unplug this product from the power source before cleaning
- Do not use liquid or aerosol cleaners. Use only a damp cloth for cleaning

Introduction:

When first using the Bluetooth Speaker please make sure that you:

Pair the Bluetooth Speaker with a Bluetooth mobile phone, computer or other Bluetooth device before making listening to music. The Bluetooth audio connection between the wireless speakers and other devices are established by setting up PAIRED links which are stored in each device ready for quick connection when requested. (Refer below for pairing detail)

The Bluetooth Speaker Support:

Wireless stereo music over Bluetooth using the A2DP/high quality audio profile.
A wired 3.5mm stereo input at the rear of the device.

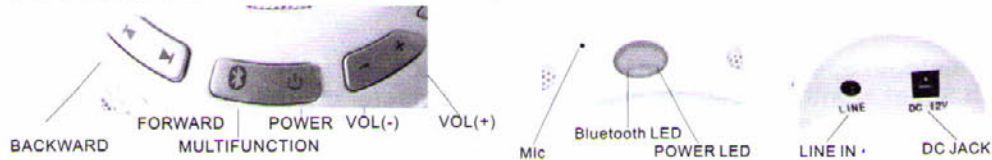

2. What is Bluetooth A2DP?

Advanced Audio Distribution Profile (A2DP) technology is a new music revolution allowing you to send CD quality stereo music from one device to another without using wires. A2DP is crystal clear music without the hassle of plugging cables. Bluetooth wireless technology with the A2DP technology makes mobile phones, PDA and computers capable of streaming music.

3. Button and symbol definitions

3.1 Button functions matrix

3.2 LED indicators

Status	LED Indicator
Speaker Power ON	Green
Bluetooth Power ON	Blue flashes rapidly and then flashes slow periodically
Bluetooth Power OFF	Red flashes and then OFF
Pairing Mode	Red and Blue LED flash
Standby Mode	Blue flash once every 2 seconds
Play Music	Blue flash once every 2 seconds




4. Using with Bluetooth mobile phone and PDA

This is an example. This procedure may differ depending on the mobile phone you are using.

1. Plug the AC Adapter into the DC In socket situated.
2. Plug the AC Adapter's plug into an electrical wall outlet.
3. Press the button and the LED will green.
3. Press the button for approximately 4 seconds until the Bluetooth Speaker LED indicator flash "blue" and "red" alternately.

5. Release the  button when the LED is flash "blue" and "red" alternately, the status indicates that the Bluetooth Speaker is in pairing mode and waiting to pair with another Bluetooth device.
6. Follow the operating instructions for your mobile phone to start a pairing process.
7. Your mobile phone's display will indicate that it found one or more Bluetooth devices, the "A-6301WS" should be included in the list, please select it for pairing.
8. The mobile display then prompt you for a pairing passkey, please Enter four zero "0000".
9. When the pairing process is finished successfully, the Bluetooth Speaker LED will return to normal status of flashing blue only.

5. Using with computer for stereo music

1. Plug the AC Adapter into the DC In socket situated.
2. Plug the AC Adapter's plug into an electrical wall outlet.
3. Press the  button and the LED will green.
4. Insert the USB Bluetooth Dongle, and open the BlueSoleil.
5. Click on the orange sun to activate a "Search for device".
6. Press the  button for approximately 3 seconds until the Bluetooth LED indicator flash "blue" and "red" alternately.
7. Release the  button when the LED is flash "blue" and "red" alternately, the status indicates that the Bluetooth Speaker is in pairing mode and waiting to pair with another Bluetooth device.
8. Your BlueSoleil's display will indicate that it found one or more Bluetooth devices, the "A-6301WS" should be included in the list, please select it for pairing.
9. The mobile display then prompt you for a pairing passkey, please Enter four zero "0000".
10. When the pairing process is finished successfully, the Bluetooth Speaker LED will return to normal status of flashing blue only.
11. Next, right click on the Bluetooth icon and select refresh services. You will see the available services headset and AV icons turn to yellow.
12. Again right click on the A-6301WM Bluetooth icon and select Default Audio Device so it is ticked.

6. Connection music players directly into the 3.5mm audio output

Equipped at the rear of Bluetooth speaker is line-in jack to directly connect stereo audio sources; such as an Mp3 play, iPod, Discman, Laptop etc

- A. Firstly, disconnect any A2DP Bluetooth connection with the Bluetooth speaker.
- B. Plug the 3.5mm audio cable into the line-in and other end to the output of the music player.
- C. Please operate all volume and track selection functions using the music player directly.
- D. All Bluetooth functional button on the Bluetooth speaker will be disabled as soon as the line-in jack is connected.
