Before using this unit, please read these instructions completely.

- Clean the Skillet plate while still warm after use by using a soft damp cloth, paper napkin or soft sponge.
- For excess soiling, after the unit is cool, wash the Skillet plate with a soft sponge moistened with a non-abrasive kitchen cleaner while flushing with warm water.
- 4. After completion of cleaning, completely wipe dry with a soft cloth. Clean the Skillet after each use.
- 5. To clean the Temperature Control Probe wipe with a dry soft cloth or paper napkin.

CAUTIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

- 1. The Skillet surface is non-stick coated, so be careful in handling.
- 2. DO NOT use sharp metal utensils or knives to cut food on the Skillet surface.
- DO NOT place the Temperature Control Probe on the Skillet surface. it may scratch or damage the surface.

USING YOUR ELECTRIC SKILLET

Before using for the first time, wash Skillet in warm soapy water, rinse and dry. DO NOT IMMERSE the UNIT in any liquid. DO NOT IMMERSE the Temperature Control probe or let the probe come in contact with any liquid.

- Make sure Temperature Dial is set to the "Min"
 Position .insert the Temperature Control Probe into the
 Skillet so the two terminal pins on the Skillet are fully
 inserted into the probe. if the Temperature Control Probe is
 not completely inserted, abnormal heating may occur,
 resulting in accident or damage.
- 2. Plug the cord in a 230-240 volt, 50HZ AC outlet only.
- 3. During cooking, the pilot light may cycle on and off indicating the desired temperature is being maintained.
- 4. After use, turn the Temperature Dial to the "OFF" position, unplug unit from outlet and then unplug the Temperature Control Probe from the Skillet.

CLEANING YOUR ELECTRIC SKILLET

1. After use, turn the Temperature Dial to the "Min" Position,

unplug the cord from the electrical outlet and remove the Temperature Control Probe from the Skillet.

NOTE: When removing the plug from the outlet, be sure to grip the plug unit with your hand instead of gripping the cord.
