For the first time use, it needs the external battery power support:

- Connect the power to the front panel. The power inlet is located next to the QNN nameplate. Please slid the nameplate sideward to expose the hole After the safe is opened, please replace the batteries into the internal battery box, which is located behind the door plate, please slid the box cover sideward to open.

• After enter the right code, turn the handle knob clockwise, Safe is new unlocked. This safe is operated by the digital code.

The factory setting for the digital code is: "1 2 3 4 5 6"

Opening instructions:

- Press the **v** on the front screen to activate the system.
- Enter the code, and then press . (Factory setting code "123456")
- OPEN displayed with 2 beeps
- **E-CODE** Displayed with 3 beeps means it is a wrong code try. 3 continual wrong code tries will be held for 15 minutes.
- Cautions: After the Holding is activated, there is no way to de-activate the Holding

within the 15 minutes period. **HOLD**** then displayed to indicate the remaining holding time in minutes

Closing instructions:

- Push the drawer at closed position
- Press to activate the system, then press again until safe is automatic locked.

Cautions: This will keep the code unchanged for next openings

Changing Code:

Please keep the drawer at open position during the whole processing until fully ensure that the code is changed correctly.

For security reasons, please change to your own code after the first opening. Your code can be set up from 4 to 6 digits

Emergency Backup

In an emergency saturation, safe can be opened by the Emergency key. (Override the digital lock). The key whole is located right hand side of the front panel, to expose the key hole you need to screw off the material plug.

Then turn the master key counter clockwise to unlock the drawer.

You need to reset a new code after open the safe using Emergency Key

To reset the code:

- Keep the Emergency key at counter clockwise position
- Press the **V** on the front screen to activate the system.
- Input your new digital code (from 4 to 6 digits), then press
- **CLOSED** Then displayed with 2 beeps and then **LO-BAT** displayed. which indicate

that the code is changed successful

- Keep the Drawer opened, turn the Emergency Key clockwise
- Using the New Code to unlock the bolts, and remember the code.

Double code system, user code and master code

- 1) User code (4-6 digits), Factory setting: 1234
- 2) Master code (6 digits), Manager code(6 digits), operate in CEU, factory setting: 123456 (CEU operation, pls check the CEU instruction manual)
- 3) With code hidden function
- 4) Holde 5mins of keypad after 3 times wrong trying

Opening

First opening: install 4 AA batteries into the external battery case, plug in the outlet which behind the Brand position, level shift the Brand position from right to left. Second: to pressing the Handle button,make handle up.

Third: Press \blacktriangleright on the panel to wake up the safe, back light on, you can see the number clearly. Input original code (1234) and \blacktriangleright , You will see "OPEN" if the code is correct. Then it will show "OPENED",Pull the handle to left (Clockwise direction), the door can be opened.

When you see the safe show "E-CODE", that means your code is wrong.

Remove the batteries from the external battery case to the battery case on the back of the door, you can use the safe without the external power supply now.

Close the door

Push the drawer to close position, press \blacktriangleright to wake up the safe, and input your code (4-6 digits), then press \blacktriangleright again, the panel shows "**CLOSE**" then "**CLOSED**", the drawer is closed automatically.

Code setting

(1) CHANGE MANAGER CODE:

Please refer to CEU user manual

(2) CHANGE PERSONAL CODE:

Under open situation, press the \blacktriangleright then input your new code (within 4-6 digits) and press \blacktriangleright again, to show "**CLOSED**". Now you will see your new code on the displayer, which means your operation succeeds.

Tips: After you change the code, please do not close the door or turn the handle at once. Follow the below steps at least 3 times to make sure your new code is work.

Press \blacktriangleright , the back light on, input your new code and \blacktriangleright . The safe will beep one time if the

code is correct, you can see "OPENED". That means the new code work now. If the code is wrong, the safe show "E-CODE" and you will hear beep 3 times. Please follow the steps of "CODE SETTING" to change the code again.

Emergency opening

If you have forgotten your personal code or for other reasons the safe cannot be opened, you can use the emergency key or CEU to open the door.

Code hidden function

Press \blacktriangleright to wake up the safe, then input \blacktriangleleft button two times and \blacktriangleright one time, you will hear beep two times. It comes into hidden code function. Repeat above steps, the code will be recovered. Code digits will be show as " \Box "

Cautions

(1) HOLD:

If you input an incorrect code 3 times, the keypad will be held for 15 minutes. During this period, there will be no response when pressing any key, and show **HOLD+Digit**, the digit is the holding time. After 15 minutes, it will recover its normal situation.

(2) LOW VOLTAGE:

When it lowers than 5V, whether the door is open or closed, it will show **LO-BAT** on the displayer.

(3) "◄" is also a deletion key; press one time will delete one digit input.
