

#### **CLEANING DISCS**

- Fingerprints and dirt on the disc cause picture and sound deterioration. Wipe the disc from the center outward with a soft cloth. Always keep the disc clean.
- If you cannot wipe off the dirt off, wipe the disc lightly with a slightly moistened soft cloth and finish with a dry cloth.
- Do not use any type of solvent such as a thinner, benzine, commercially available cleaners or anti-static spray for vinyl LP's.



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



#### OPERATING WITH THE REMOTE CONTROL

Operating player with the remote control.



The remote control must point at the remote sensor in order for the remote to function correctly.

Distance: Maximum of 7 m from the front of the remote sensor.

**Angle:** Approximately 30° from each direction.

\*Do not place the remote control under intense light source such as direct sunlight.



#### **BATTERIES**

INCORRECT USE OF BATTERIES MIGHT CAUSE THEM TO LEAK, CORRODE OR EXPLODE.

- Do not place the batteries in the wrong direction.
- It is dangerous to charge, heat, open, or short-circuit the batteries.

- If battery leakage occurs, wipe the battery liquid from the battery compartment, then replace batteries.





## VCR Playback

Press the AFF button on your remote control, this will eliminate black bars on the top & bottom of the TV screen when viewing movies with an aspect ratio of 1.85:1 and minimize (but not eliminate) black bars on movies with a wider aspect ratio (2.35:1).
