Note:

- Press 4, 5, 17, 18 for more than 1.5s, there will be functions marked on these buttons(MENU, TITLE, ANGLE, PROG).
- Press 4, 5, 17, 18 for less than 1s, there will be functions marked above these buttons(ZOOM, SUBTITLE, AUDIO, REPEAT).
- The USB button only works when there is no disc in the DVD player or when the disc doesn't play. When the DVD tray is opened or a disc is playing, the USB button is deactivated.

Connections



CONNECT DVD PLAYER TO TV SET WITH SCART SOCKET

Use the SCART cable to connect DVD player and your TV. Set the [Video Out] to [Composite] or [RGB].

• CONNECT DVD PLAYER TO TV SET WITH HDMI CABLE

Use the HDMI cable to connect DVD player and your TV. Set the [Video Out] to [HDMI].

CONNECT DVD PLAYER TO AV AMPLIFIER WITH DIGITAL AUDIO(COAXIAL) OUTPUT

- 1. Connect the coaxial digital audio output to the AV amplifier.
- 2. Set the DVD player's [Digital Output] to [Raw] or [PCM]
- 3. Set the AV Amplifier to the digital input connected to the DVD player.

SYSTEM SETUP

MENU OPERATION

Press the SETUP button on the remote control, the SETUP MENU will be displayed. After accessing the setup menu, press the direction buttons for up and down movement to select an item desired, then press the OK button to confirm. Press LEFT direction button return to the menu of upper level. To exit the setup, press the SETUP button again. In the SETUP MENU, you may choose any of the following options as you like.

LANGUAGE SETUP

Select Language in the setup menu, and display the Language submenu:



OSD Language

Use this item to select the language of the setup menu and screen display.

Subtitle

This option provides the preset subtitle language.

MPEG4 Subtitle(optional)

Select different MPEG4 subtitle encoding option.

Note: Not all players support this item.

Audio

Select the built-in disc dubbing language options.

DVD Menu

This option provides the film's menu language options.

VIDEO SETUP

Select Video in the setup menu, and display the Video submenu:



SYSTEM SETUP

Aspect Ratio

Select the aspect ratio.

Notes:

The image display ratio is related to the recorded disc format. Some disc can not display images in the aspect ratio you choose. If you play a disc recorded in 4:3 format on a wide screen TV, black bars will appear on the left and right side of the screen. You must adjust the screen setting depending on the type of the television you have.

TV System

Select the different TV system. **Note:** The DVD player setting should be matched to your TV set. For more information of output format, refer to the instructions or your TV set.

Video Out

Select the video output format wanted. **Note:** Only HDMI DVD player has "HD" selection.

HD Resolution (optional)

After you set the video output to HD output, you can choose the resolution of HDMI output. *Note:* Only HDMI DVD player has this item. Supports 480p, 576p, 720p, 1080i, 1080p

AUDIO SETUP

Select Audio in the setup menu, and display the Audio submenu.



Digital output(Optional)

Adjust the audio output on Coaxial ports to work in harmony with the audio equipment (e.g. receiver, amplifier) connected to the player.

Off Digital audio output is disabled.

PCM Transfer stereo 2 channels signals

RAW: Transfer the DVD original audio track

Note: This item is only for the player with coaxial output.

Down sampling

Select down sampling function on or off. ON: System will down sampling rate for high sampling rate audio(more than 96K). OFF: Disable this function.

SYSTEM SETUP

RATING SETUP

Select Rating in the setup menu, and display the Rating submenu:



Parental Control

Set the parental control feature of the player **Note:** Password is needed before setting Parental Control.

Set Password

Input four digits (password), then press **OK** to confirm. **Note:** If you forget your password, please use the universal password 6666 to unlock.

MISC SETUP

Select **MISC** in the setup menu, and display the submenu:



Use Default Settings

Reset setup data to factory default value.

Screen Saver(Optional)

Enable/disable the screen saver function. *Note: Not all player has this item.*

The unit can support : DVD, DVD+/-R/RW, VCD, CD, CD-R, JPEG, HDCD, kodak CD, MPEG4, MP3, S-VCD, WMA, VOB

MP3/WMA/JPEG/MPEG4 PLAYBACK



The MP3/WMA/MPEG4 disc has such a directory structure as shown picture above. Press **Direction key** to choose the root directory and then press **OK** button to enter into the sub directory. Press **Direction key** to choose the desired track and then press **OK** or **PLAY** to enjoy the music or movie. If you want to return to the upper menu, press **Direction key** to choose **E** the icon and press **OK** button.

Filter: Allows selecting the categories of files displayed in the browser list.

Repeat: To switch different repeat playing mode

Mode: Select different playing mode as follows:

Normal: Shuffle mode is cancelled.

Shuffle: Shuffle mode enabled. When playback reaches the end of the current chapter/track, playback jumps to a random chapter/track. As the end of each chapter/track is reached, another random chapter/track will be played until all tracks/chapters have been played or the Shuffle mode is cancelled by toggling to a different **Mode** Option.

Music Intro: In this mode, the media will play 10 seconds and then skip to next media. Edit Mode: To enable programmed playback mode. When you select the mode, press LEFT

Direction key to directory and press OK to choose the desired track and press Add to program to start program playback.

Program view: Display program track.

Brower view: Display track directory.

Add to program: Choice the track press **Add to program** to add the track of the program play directory.

Clear program: In the complete stop state(press the **STOP** button twice), choose the track press **Clear program** to delete the track of the program play directory.

PICTURE CD PLAYBACK

The PICTURE CD disc has such a directory structure structure as shown in the following picture.

Press **Direction key** to choose the root directory and then press **OK** button to enter into the sub directory. Press **Direction key** to choose the desired picture and then press **OK** or **PLAY** to enjoy the picture. If you want to return to the upper menu, press **Direction key** to choose the icon and press **OK** button.

Image rotation

In picture play state, press **Direction key** to rotate the picture, press ANGLE button to change the picture scan mode.

USB

USB

If the player has a USB slot and it's NOT in "disc playing" status, you can insert a USB device or a MP3 Player with USB Interface to play the MP3 music or and JPEG files. All the function is the same to play a disc.

Note: When inserting the USB device, please do not insert in the wrong direction. Otherwise the USB device or player may be damaged.

When the disc is playing, please stop playing first and then enjoy USB by press USB key on the remote controller .

Not all USB device can be supported by this system.

Warning: The USB memory stick should be plug in the unit directly. USB extension able should not be used to avoid failing of data transferring and interference caused.

Troubleshooting

If you have any questions, please consult the troubleshooting guide below.

NO PICTURE OR SOUND

- · Ensure the power button is on.
- Ensure the power outlet is operational.
- · Ensure the power cord is not damaged.
- · Ensure the power plug is connected firmly to the outlet.

PICTURE BUT NO SOUND

- · Ensure the audio jacks are securely connected.
- · Ensure the audio connector is not damaged.
- · Ensure the volume is turned up in VOUCH setup.
- Ensure you have set the player's AUDIO settings correctly.
- · Ensure you have entered the correct AV input for your TV
- · Ensure the audio is not set to mute.

"BAD DISC" DISPLAYED

- · Ensure the disc is not warped, damaged or deformed.
- · Ensure the disc is not badly stained or damaged.
- · Ensure the disc format is compatible with the player.
- · Please check whether you have tried to play a software CD. If so, please restart the player.

REMOTE NOT WORKING

- Make sure the Main units POWER button is on
- · Ensure the remote batteries are working.
- Point the remote control directly at the player's IR sensor.
- · Remove any obstacles between the remote and the IR sensor.

SOUND BUT NO PICTURE

- · Ensure the video jacks are securely connected.
- · Ensure you have entered the correct AV input for your TV
- · Ensure the video connector is not damaged.
- · Ensure you have set the player's VIDEO settings correctly.

UNIT NOT WORKING

• Turn off the power, and then turn it on again.

POOR PICTURE OR SOUND

- Ensure you have set the player's AUDIO settings correctly. . Ensure you have put the disc on the tray.
- · Ensure the disc is not scratched or stained.
- · Ensure the AV connector or the output terminal is not damaged.

"NO DISC" DISPLAYED

- · Ensure the disc is not upside down.
- · Ensure the disc is not distorted, stained or scratched.
