
Automatic transmission:

- P = park
- R = reverse
- N = neutral D = drive

The selector lever can only be moved out of P or N when the ignition is on and the foot brake is depressed (selector lever lock).

To engage **P** or **R**, push the release button on the selector lever.

When position N is selected, depress foot brake or apply parking brake before starting.



Starting the engine:

- Turn key to position 1 Move steering wheel slightly to
- release steering wheel lock
- Manual transmission in neutral with clutch depressed
- Automatic transmission in P or N with brake pedal depressed Do not accelerate
- Diesel engines:
- Turn key to position **2** for preheating and wait for \mathfrak{W} to extinguish in instrument cluster
- Turn key to position 3 and release when engine is running



- **A** = Switch between Automatic

When starting off, depress foot brake and move selector lever to A. + or -. The transmission is in Automatic mode and first gear is engaged.


In **A**, first gear is engaged and the clutch is released when the vehicle is stopped.



Manual transmission: Reverse gear:

With vehicle stationary, wait 3 seconds after depressing clutch pedal, press release button on selector lever and engage gear.

If the gear does not engage, set the lever to neutral, release the clutch pedal and depress again; then repeat gear selection.

To reduce the operating forces of the parking brake, depress the foot brake at the same time.



Refuellina:

Before refuelling, switch off engine the bracket on the fuel filler flap. and any external heaters with combustion chambers (identified close tank flap. by sticker on fuel filler flap). Wipe off any overflowing fuel.

Switch off mobile phones.

Fuel filler flap is located at right rear side of vehicle.

In vehicles with remote control central locking, the fuel filler flap can only be opened if the vehicle is unlocked.

Vehicle features

Tyre pressure:

Check tyre pressures, including the spare, every 14 days and prior to any long journey; tyres should be checked when cold. This also applies to vehicles with type pressure monitoring system. The tyre pressure data refers to cold tyres. It applies to summer and winter tyres. Always inflate the spare tyre to the value specified for full load. The ECO tyre pressure serves to achieve the smallest amount of fuel consumption possible. Incorrect tyre pressures will impair safety, vehicle handling, comfort and fuel economy and increase tyre wear.






Corsa **Ouick Reference Guide**

Central locking:

To lock or unlock doors from inside the vehicle, press central locking button in the centre console with the doors closed.

The LED in the button illuminates for approx. 2 minutes after locking with the remote control.

If the doors are locked from inside whilst driving, the LED remains illuminated.

The vehicle can also be configured to unlock only the driver's door when pressing button \geq once on towards the rear to lock the vehicle. the remote control. Pressing \succeq twice will unlock the entire vehicle.

Electronic immobiliser:

Activated automatically when key is removed from ignition switch.

Longitudinal seat adjustment: Pull handle, slide seat, release handle. Ensure the backrest engages.

In vehicles with automatic opening and closing, operate the switch again to stop window movement.

If the window glass encounters resistance during automatic closing, it is immediately stopped and opened again.

If the windows are operated repeatedly at short intervals, window operation is temporarily disabled.



Electrical exterior mirrors: (Version with manual window operation)

Select the relevant exterior mirror with the switch.

Use the control to adjust the mirror.



Operating windows from outside: Depending on the equipment level, the windows can be operated remotely from outside the vehicle.

Press button \geq or = on the remote control until all windows have opened or closed.



Light switch:

- c = Activation or deactivation When the automatic light control is of automatic light control active and the engine is running, (switch returns to AUTO)
- AUTO = Automatic light control: Headlights are switched on and off automatically


Headlight range adjustment ^{‡D}: Adapt headlight range to the vehicle load to prevent dazzling of Headlight flash = Pull lever other road users.

Seat position: Sit with buttocks as far back against backrest as possible.

Automatic light control:

the system switches between daytime running lights and headlights, depending on external lighting conditions.

During poor external lighting conditions, the headlights will switch on automatically.

Daytime running lights increase visibility of the vehicle during daylight. The tail lights are not

illuminated.

low beam:

Hiah beam

When a tunnel is entered, the headlights switch on automatically.



Front fog lights:

Operated with the D button. Light switch in position AUTO: switching on front fog lights will switch headlights on automatically.


Rear fog light:

Operated with the Of button.

Rear fog light can only be switched on when both the ignition and headlights or sidelights (with front fog lights) are switched on.

Light switch in position AUTO: switching on rear fog light will switch headlights on automatically.

Vehicle rear fog light is deactivated when towing.



Vehicle features

Hazard warning flashers: Operated with the \triangle button.

In the event of an accident where the airbags are deployed the hazard warning flashers are activated automatically.



Windscreen wiper:

= = Fast

- = Slow

- -- = Timed interval wiping or automatic wiping with rain sensor
- 0 = Off

For a single wipe when the windscreen wiper is off, press the lever down.

Do not use if the windscreen is frozen

Switch off in car washes.



Windscreen washer:

Pull lever. Washer fluid is sprayed onto the windscreen and the wiper wipes a few times.

On vehicles fitted with a rain sensor, keep the sensor area clean by operating the washer system regularly.



Headlight flash, high beam and

Turn and lane-change signals: Lever up = Right turn signal Lever down = Left turn signal

If the lever is moved past the resistance point, the turn signal is switched on constantly. When the steering wheel is moved back the turn signal is automatically deactivated.

For three flashes, e.g. when changing lanes, press the lever until resistance is felt and then release.

Move lever to resistance point and hold for longer indication.

Switch the turn signal off manually by moving the lever slightly.



Rear window wiper/washer: Push lever forwards. The rear window wiper wipes in timed interval mode.

Switch off by pushing lever forwards again.

Do not use if the rear window is frozen

Switch off in car washes.

If the lever is held forwards, washer fluid is sprayed onto the rear window.

Rear window wiper comes on automatically when the windscreen wiper is switched on and reverse gear is engaged

The vehicle can be configured to activate or deactivate this function



Heated rear window, heated exterior mirrors:

The heating is operated by pressing the 💷 button.

Heating works with the engine running and is switched off automatically after a short time.

Depending on engine type, heating comes on automatically during driving when the diesel particle filter is being cleaned.



Demisting and defrosting the windows:

- Set air distribution to 3
- Set temperature control to the warmest level
- Set fan speed to the highest level
- Switch cooling 🌣 on
- Switch heated rear window
- Open side air vents and direct them towards the door windows
