



Before Using The Monitor

- •To safely use the product, please read the user's manual carefully before use.
- Connect all lines as directed in the product connection map in the manual.
- Do not touch the LCD panel.
- Use the product at the temperature range of -15° C $\sim 60^{\circ}$ C.
- Screen may be a little dark when the product is operated in low temperature areas. Screen will show normal luminosity after a few minutes.
- Do not disassemble and modify the product in any way.
 This may cause fire and/or electric shock.
- When you install the product in a car, do not set a volume level too loud for others to hear outside.
- When you install the product in a car and watch TV, the car engine should be running as there might occur excessive discharge of the car battery.
- Any liquid leaking into product may cause malfunction.
- Precautions (when you use the product in a car)
 - The driver should not use the product while he/she is driving.
 - Quality of pictures on screen may vary depending on the radio field strength in different locations. You should use video equipment where you experience weak radio field strength.
 - Follow traffic laws when you use the Navigation Route System.
 - Be cautious of humidity and shock when you use the product in a car.
 - The product should not be placed on the dashboard or near engine
 - Cover the product when exposed to direct rays of the sun for a long period of time. (You should keep the product at a temperature range of -30° C $\sim 85^{\circ}$ C.)

TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

Remote control unit doesn't work

- Batteries are missing, dead or incorrect polarity Replace batteries
- Remote control distance is too far The distance must be less than 5m
- Improper direction of remote control
 Point the remote control unit to the sensor

No picture and sound

 A/V source connection is wrong Check the A/V source power

IR sensor inoperative

- · Verify that batteries in the remote are fresh
- · Verify that remote eye is not obstructed
- Verify that the infrared transmitter is affixed over the sensor eye
 of the component to be controlled




Improper handling from ignoring the following may result in serious injury or death.


- Do not watch TV programs or operate the monitor while driving. This may cause a car accident because of the distraction.
- Keep liquids away from the monitor. (This can lead to electrical shock)
- Do not install the monitor where it may be viewable to the driver or obstruct an air bag device.
- In case of smoke or a strange odor emitting from the monitor, power off the equipment and contact your local dealer.
- Do not attempt to service the product on your own. Disconnect power to the unit and take it to your local dealer.
- Dropping the unit can cause internal mechanical failure.
- Dispose of remote control batteries in a proper place. Placing batteries in fires or incorrect recharging will cause batteries to explode.



- Adjust the volume to a moderate listening level. (While driving, keep the volume at a level at which you can still hear noises outside the vehicle such as emergency response vehicles)
- Do not watch TV / Video while the vehicle's engine is off. (This may drain the battery and you
 might not be able to start your vehicle)
- The monitor should be mounted in a position so that it is situated out of direct sunlight, heat, water, or moisture. (This product is made with precise electronic components that should be handled with care. Do not let it fail due to improper use or carelessness)
- Hitting or striking the unit is prohibited under warranty. (It may cause damage to the unit and / or personal injury. If LCD glass is broken, do no touch the liquid or the screen. If hands or clothes come in contact with the liquid, clean it up with soap and water)
- On not open the monitor body. (It may cause electrical shock or damage to the unit)
- In case of changing a fuse, make sure to replace it with the same amperage fuse it came with. (Replacing the fuse with a higher amperage fuse may cause the unit to malfunction. Unplug the power cord while changing the fuse to prevent a short circuit)
- Use the supplied screws to mount the monitor stand. (Make sure the monitor stand is firmly mounted to a secure location)





FUNCTION

- 1. The Picture revers function allows you to rotate the screen 180 degrees and view the picture upside-down. This is very useful if you are mounting the monitor upside-down in the vehicle such as on the roof or ceiling. This can be controlled by using the remote.
- 2. The monitor has a specially designed micro IC that allows the video signal from V2 to be displayed on the screen while keeping V1 as the priority signal. This means you can connect V2 to a backup or reverse camera and when switching to the reverse gear, the monitor will automatically switch from AV1 to V2 input to show the camera view.

Changing Batteries




① Pull battery case in the direction of the arrow.



② Place a battery with the ⊕ sign upward on the battery case.



3 Put the battery case back into the remote control in the direction of the arrow.



WARNING

Investigate the layout of your automobile thoroughly before drilling or cutting any holes. Take care when you work near gas tanks, gas lines, hydraulic lines, and electrical wiring. Do not use the power amplifier unmounted. Attach the system securely to the automobile to prevent damage, particularly in the event of an accident. Do not mount the system so that the wire connections are unprotected or are subject to pinching or damage from nearby objects.

The +12V DC power wire must be fused at the battery positive terminal connection. Before making or breaking power connections at the system power terminals, disconnect the +12V wire at the battery end. Confirm your radio/head unit and/or other equiptment is turned off while connecting the input jacks and speaker terminals. If you need to replace the power fuse, replace it only with a fuse identical to that supplied with the system. Using a fuse of a different type or rating may result in damage to this system which is not covered by the warranty.
