4. Connecting Devices

4.1 Step 1: Plug in the Power Outlet

4.2 Step 2: Connecting the components

4.2.1 Connecting to a Projector

• Connect the VGA OUT on the 445 to the VGA IN on the projector using the VGA cable.



4.2.2 Connecting to a Monitor

• Connect the VGA PASSTHROUGH on the 445 to the VGA IN on the monitor using the VGA cable. <Note> The VGA PASSTHROUGH connector only outputs VGA IN signals.



4.2.3 Connecting to a TV

1.Using EXTENDER and C-Video cable to connect EXTENDER of 445 to a C-Video of TV.



- 2. Adjust DIP Switch Setting
 - NTSC : America, Taiwan, Panama, Philippine, Canada, Chile, Japan, and Mexico.
