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

safety precautions

WARNING

1. Be sure to use only the standard adapter that is specified in the specification sheet. Using any other adapter could cause fire, electrical shock, or damage to the product.
2. Incorrectly connecting the power supply or replacing battery may cause explosion, fire, electric shock, or damage to the product.
3. Do not connect multiple cameras to a single adapter. Exceeding the capacity may cause abnormal heat generation or fire.
4. Securely plug the power cord into the power receptacle. Insecure connection may cause fire.
5. When installing the camera, fasten it securely and firmly. A falling camera may cause personal injury.
6. Do not place conductive objects (e.g. screwdrivers, coins, metal things, etc.) or containers filled with water on top of the camera.
Doing so may cause personal injury due to fire, electric shock, or falling objects.
7. Do not install the unit in humid, dusty, or sooty locations.
Doing so may cause fire or electric shock.
8. If any unusual smells or smoke come from the unit, stop using the product.
In such case, immediately disconnect the power source and contact the service centre. Continued use in such a condition may cause fire or electric shock.
9. If this product fails to operate normally, contact the nearest service centre.
Never disassemble or modify this product in any way. (SAMSUNG is not liable for problems caused by unauthorized modifications or attempted repair.)
10. When cleaning, do not spray water directly onto parts of the product.
Doing so may cause fire or electric shock.

CAUTION

1. Do not drop objects on the product or apply strong shock to it.
Keep away from a location subject to excessive vibration or magnetic interference.

9. The Mains plug is used as a disconnect device and shall stay readily operable at any time.

important safety instructions

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

things to keep in mind during installation and use

- Do not disassemble the camera on your own.
- Always be careful when handling the camera. Do not strike the camera by your fists or shake it. Please be careful not to be careless when storing and operating it.
- Do not place or operate the camera in any wet environment such as rain or wet surfaces.
- Do not clean the camera with rough sandpaper. Please always use a dry cloth when cleaning it.
- Put the camera in a cool area free from direct sunlight. Otherwise, the camera may be damaged.

function & installation

FUNCTION

- 1 Protective Film over Front Glass :** Remove this film before operating the Camera.
- 2 Focus/Zoom Lever Bolt Screws:** Used to fix the Focus/Zoom ring to the lens internally.
Be careful not to lose this small bolt screws which need not be touched other than by a service technician.
- 3 Focus/Zoom Ring Fixing Screws:** Used to fix the Focus/Zoom Ring at the desired position after adjusting the lens angle and focus setting as described below.
- 4 Focus and Zoom Ring:** These two rings are used to accurately adjust the viewing angle and to sharply focus all objects within the lens field of view.
 - Loosen the fixing screws (**3**) to turn the Zoom and Focus ring.
 - i) To widen the viewing angle turn the "Zoom Ring" to "W" (Wide).
 - ii) To obtain a closer view turn this ring to "T" (Tele).
 - After adjustment of the viewing angle then adjust the "Focus Ring" between "N" (Near) or "∞" (Far) until the sharpest focus is achieved.
 - Then tighten the fixing screws (**3**) on each ring.
 - After tightening you should check that angle and focus is still accurate.
- 5 DC Level Volume Screw Cap :**
 - Loosen the DC level volume screw cap on the camera body.
 - i) For a brighter screen turn the DC level volume slowly toward "H" (counter-clockwise),
 - ii) For a darker screen turn it toward "L" (clockwise) with a driver.
- 6 Bracket :** Used to install the camera to the desired location.

INSTALLATION METHOD

Bracket & Camera Mounting

- Install the Mounting Bracket at the desired location.

Connecting to Monitor and Power

- Set the impedance switch to the 75 Ω standard position unless a video equipment is connected to the monitor video out.
- Adaptor: AC24V / 800mA or DC12V / 1A (AC24V / DC12V Model)



- Be sure to connect power after all the installation is done.
- Do not use power sources other than that specified.

- After adjusting view angle, cap over the camera with the sun-shield and fix it to the camera with the sun-shield bolt.

If you have trouble operating the camera, check the following guides for the possible problem.

- **Nothing appears on the screen.**
 - Check the power connection and video signal line connection.
 - Check the brightness level of DC Auto Iris volume of the camera.
- **The video image is not clear.**
 - Check if the camera glass has dust on the surface.
Clean the camera glass with a clean cloth or brush.
 - Make sure that the screen is not exposed directly to a bright light.
Adjust the position of the camera if necessary.
 - Check if protective film of camera glass is removed.
- **The screen is dark**
 - Adjust the brightness feature of the monitor.
 - Check the brightness level of DC Auto Iris volume of the camera.
- **The screen does not properly display when IR LEDs work.**
 - Check if the camera glass has dust.
 - Clean the camera glass with a clean cloth or brush.






