
Loading batteries to the remote control

- . Remove the battery compartment cover.
- Load two AAA (UM-4 or R03) batteries into the battery compartment.
- Make sure that the batteries have been inserted in the correct polarities matching to the symbols +, - marked in the battery compartment. Close the battery compartment cover.
- When replacing batteries, replace both batteries.
   Do not mix new and used batteries operating together, otherwise, the operation lifetime will be much shorter than normal.
- Remove the batteries if the unit will not be used for a prolonged period of time.







#### **Automatic Play**

The unit will take a few seconds to download the disc initial data, display the disc type logo in the left upper corner of the V screen, and then start playing automatically .

#### If a DVD Disc Menu appears on screen



NOTE Normally, when a MP3 disc is loaded, the unit will take longer time to download the initial data.

DVD disc that does not match the region code cannot be executed by this player.

Return to the disc main menu, press MENU button on the remote.

Prevent loading the disc upside down.

## Screen saver

The player is equipped with an automatic screen saver, for the purpose of protecting the TV screen.

The TV screen will be black and a screen Saver will appear on screen if :

- · No disc is loaded for 300 seconds
- In STOP mode and no button has been Pressed for 300 seconds. (except in the player or disc menu)

When any button is pressed, the player will resume to normal active mode.






#### Loading a DVD or VCD Disc:


Press RIGHT, Audio sub menu appears.



Highlight the desired item and press RIGHT button, Highlight the desired item,

Press RIGHT button to confirm.

Press SETUP button to save the setting and quit.



#### RATING

Enter this menu to setup the rating level of the player.

The player will require a password to play any disc with rating level higher than the setting.

Press SETUP button.

Highlight "Rating", press RIGHT button, Rating sub menu appears.



Highlight "Parental Control" selection, press ENTER, input the 4 digits password, press ENTER button. The rating lock release.



Press RIGHT button and scroll down to the desired rating you need, then press enter again to change the setting:

### Misc

 Using the UP/DOWN direction buttons, move to the Misc. The player's Misc settings will appear.



Press SETUP button to save the setting and quit.

- 2. Use the RIGHT direction buttons to skip to select the setting.
- 3. Use the UP/DOWN direction to choose the setting.
- Press ENTER for each setting to cycle through the options and change the settings.

The following subsections explain the available options for each of the player's Misc setting.

Use Default Settings:

Press ENTER, pop up window " Do You Want to use default setting ".

There are two selections: YES/NO.



No=Return to Use Default Setting Yes=Close Setup menu, play disc.

## TROUBLE SHOOTING

Should your DVD player develop a problem, please check below before requesting service:

Symptom	Check and Action
No Power	<ul> <li>Check if the power cord has been properly connected to the power outlet.</li> <li>Check if the main power has been switched on.</li> </ul>
Does not play	<ul> <li>No disc, load a disc.</li> <li>Disc has been loaded upside down. Place the disc with the label side up.</li> <li>Disc's region code does not match to the player.</li> <li>Disc is not correct type for player.</li> <li>Disc is damaged or dirty, clean the disc or try another disc.</li> <li>Moisture may be condensed inside the player. Remove the disc and leave the unit power on for one or two hours.</li> </ul>
No Picture	<ul> <li>Check if the TV set has power on, use TV remote to select A/V signal for DVD rather than broadcast.</li> <li>Check if the system connection is proper and secure.</li> <li>Check if the connection cables are damaged.</li> <li>Clean the disc.</li> </ul>
Picture noise / distorted	<ul> <li>The disc is dirty or damaged. Clean the disc or try another disc.</li> <li>Reset the color system of the player or the TV set.</li> <li>Try to direct the player to the TV set instead of via other components, such as a VCR.</li> </ul>
Picture not full screen	<ul> <li>Select the screen format from the player's SETUP MENU, see "SETUP MENU" of this manual.</li> <li>Select the screen format from DVD disc menu.</li> </ul>
Malfunction	<ul> <li>Should the player develop a malfunction, unplug the player for 30 minutes. After 30 minutes, power on the player and the restore function should reset the player.</li> </ul>

No sound or sound output not complete	<ul> <li>Check if the TV and Amplifier have been switched on, and correctly set.</li> <li>Check if the TV and Amplifier system connection is secured.</li> <li>Press LANGUAGE button to select other audio tracks output of disc.</li> <li>Check if the MUTE function of the TV or Amplifier has been activated.</li> <li>There will be no sound output during PAUSE / STEP / SLOW and SEARCH.</li> </ul>
MP3 disc no sound or noisy	<ul> <li>When PC program files or other data files are mixed with MP3 files in the same disc, the player may play the non-MP3 files with noise or no sound.</li> <li>Check the disc, if all the files on disc are MP3 files Skip the file, try other files.</li> </ul>
Remote control does not function	<ul> <li>Remove the obst acles between the remote control and the player.</li> <li>Point the remote control towards the remote sensor on the player.</li> <li>Check if the batteries of the remote control have been loaded with correct polarities.</li> <li>Replace the batteries of the remote control.</li> </ul>
