



THIS VEHICLE USES A POWER WHEELS® TYPE H BATTERY AND A POWER WHEELS TYPE H CHARGER ONLY. NO OTHER TYPE WILL WORK. Even with proper care, the rechargeable battery will not last forever. The replacement battery must be a Type H battery.





It is important that you use only Power Wheels® Type H batteries.







REMOVE batteries from package.
INSERT fuses into batteries.



STACK one battery connector on top of the other and snap together.



Your vehicle has the Power Wheels® Lock-IntM connectors.
SQUEEZE tabs on charger and push into battery connectors to lock in.
(To disconnect, simply squeeze tabs and pull.)


A CAUTION

Leaving the batteries in a discharged condition will ruin them. Batteries must be charged once a month even if the vehicle is not used. Carefully read the battery care instructions in the Owner's Manual to obtain the best battery life.


PLUG battery charger into wall outlet.
CHARGE batteries for a minimum of 18 hours for the first charge. (After that, 14 hours is enough.)
Power Wheels® recommends not charging over 30 hours.

STEERING COLUMN / STEERING WHEEL



TURN vehicle upside down. SLIDE steering column through holes in underside of body and through hole in top of body.



INSERT curved end of steering column through hole in steering linkage.


Insert two 1/2" screws (with sharp points) into holes.

SUPPORT steering column under vehicle.
PLACE steering wheel onto

steering column.
NOTE: Slotted grilles of steering wheel must be facing downwards.

PLACE retainer onto steering column.

HAMMER retainer secure using steering wheel tool.





INSTALL three batteries into sound box.

(Batteries Not Included)


KEEP THESE BATTERIES AND OTHER SMALL PARTS AWAY FROM CHILDREN.

DROP sound box into steering wheel.



SNAP steering wheel cover onto steering wheel.

LIGHT-BAR / SEAT BELT INSTALLATION




INSERT plastic clip on end of each seat belt into the body. PULL back to lock in place.

SLIDE both loops of seat belts onto light-bar.



PLACE light-bar into holes in rear of body. (The light-bar should slant toward the rear of the vehicle.)


INSERT light-bar support tube.

PLACE light-bar brackets on both the light-bar and support tube.



INSERT 1" screw into each bracket. TIGHTEN. REPEAT for other side.




SLIP seat belt into slots in light rack.
PLACE KC® light rack onto light-bar.





INSERT 1-1/2" screw into underside of light rack. TIGHTEN. REPEAT for other side.



DISSASSEMBLE KC® LIGHT/GUARD ASSEMBLY. SLIDE KC light back onto rack.




PLACE KC light front onto light back.
INSERT 1/2" screw with sharp point.


APPLY KC LIGHT® DECAL BEFORE THIS STEP. SNAP KC light guard onto light. REPEAT for other side.

SEAT / REAR BUMPER



SLIDE seat under seat belts. INSERT tabs on front of seat into slots in body.



TILT seat backward. PUSH down to lock into place.



INSERT tabs on rear bumper into slots in body.
PRESS to snap into place.



TAILLIGHTS / GAS CAP / TAILGATE



ASSEMBLE taillight lenses and holders.




INSERT two 1" screws through assembly into body. TIGHTEN. REPEAT for other side.

SNAP gas cap/flange assembly into place as shown.



POSITION left side of tailgate into hole in body.
SLIDE right side into place.



WINDSHIELD





PLACE windshield hinge into position, with open side facing front.


INSERT two 1/2" screws with blunt point into hinge.
TIGHTEN.
REPEAT for other side.


ALIGN holes in windshield with holes in hinges.
PLACE 3" screw through holes in windshield and hinge.
TIGHTEN.
REPEAT for other side.

ACCESSORIES





INSERT microphone cord firmly into hole in dash. PULL back on cord to lock into place. HANG microphone on slot.

ALIGN tabs on grill with holes in body.
PRESS into place



SLIDE radiator decal sheet between grill and front body.



FRONT BUMPER / HEADLIGHT LENSES


PLACE one tab of headlight lens into body.
PUSH other tab into hole in body by gently pushing tab toward center of lens.
REPEAT for other side.

INSERT tabs on front of bumper into slots in body. INSERT two 1/2" screws through bumper into body. TIGHTEN.

DECALS



PROPER DECAL APPLICATION WILL KEEP THE DECALS LOOKING THEIR BEST!

WASH your hands before applying decals. WIPE the vehicle with a soft **dry** cloth to remove dust.


REMOVE decal from backing sheet.

ALIGN decal in desired postiion. LAY down one edge of decal, then slowly lay down the rest of the decal rubbing toward the center as you go.

After decal is in position.


RUB the decal firmly with the cloth to be sure adhesive is in firm contact.

BATTERY INSTALLATION





OPEN hood. PLACE batteries in compartment.





SQUEEZE tabs on motor harness and push into battery connectors to lock in.

INSERT ends of battery retainer into holes in body.



REPLACE 1" screw (with sharp point) in battery retainer. CLOSE hood.

IMPORTANT

Carefully read your Owner's Manual for important safety messages and operating instructions before using your vehicle.

REMEMBER

THE FIRST TIME . . . Charge the batteries for a minimum of 18 hours.

AFTER THAT . . . Charge the batteries a minimum of 14 hours.

HIGH-SPEED CONNECTION

Your vehicle is now ready to go. For safety reasons, it will only operate

in low speeds. To connect high-speed see Owner's Manual.
