
# **PPG260A Guitar Amplifier**

- 1) Power Switch: Switches amplifier on/off.
- 2) Power LED: Illuminates when power is switched on.
- 3) Input Jack: Connect your instrument to this jack.
- 4) Volume: This sets the volume gain level.
- 5) Bass: This control adjusts the low frequency level.
- 6) Treble: This control adjusts the high frequency level.
- 7) Phones Jack: This is your headphone connection. Inserting the headphones disables the internal speaker (great for practicing).



- 1) Voltage Selector: 110/220 Volt Selectable Switch.
- 2) Power Cord: Connect cord to an AC outlet.

## **Troubleshooting**

#### Distorted Sound:

Check if the amplifier is overdriven. If it is, you will have to turn the level down.
Check signal source.

### Signal sounds discolored:

Check and adjust the EQ settings. Ensure you are using quality cables. Check signal source.

#### No Sound:

Check connections.
Try a different cable.
Check level on amplifier.
Confirm amplifier is getting a signal.
Make sure nothing is plugged into the Phones jack.

## Intermittent Output:

Check connections.
Try a different cable.
