Programming And Operating Instructions

> To have a clearer idea of the features and capabilities of your remote control, take a moment to read these instructions. Save for future reference.

1. Introduction

Your CheckMate™ II universal remote control is simple to program, easy to use, and can operate two (2) devices, which include

CABLE Cable set-top terminals TV Televisions

Before you can use your remote control, it must be programmed (set-up) to operate the above devices.

Programming your remote is a simple procedure using Point and Press™ Programming, an automatic method whereby the remote self-programs to each of your devices, without using codes.

2. Installing / Replacing Batteries

Install four (4) new "AA" batteries as indicated by the diagram in the battery compartment.

When the indicator light becomes dim or no longer illuminates during use, install 4 new "AA" size batteries.

Your remote control has Memory Guard [™], which eliminates reprogramming after battery changes.

3. Programming Your CABLE Set-Top Terminal

Model RT-U27A iPG : Pre-programmed to operate the Motorola DCT® digital and CFT2200 analog set-top terminals (Cable setup code 001). Model RT-U27B iPG: Pre-programmed to operate the Scientific-Atlanta Explorer®, Pioneer Voyager® and Pace 510 digital set-top terminals (Cable setup code 004).

Model RT-U27AB iPG : Preprogrammed to operate the Motorola DCT® (Cable setup code 109). 2

Programming your CABLE set - top device ...

1. Press [CBL], then [MUTE] together - hold both buttons down until the indicator light illuminates red.

2. From the CABLE Setup Code list, locate and enter the 3-digit code for your brand and model

3. Press [CBL] to lock in code. The indicator light will blink and go out. Write your CABLE set top brand & setup code _

4. Programming Your TV

Programming Your TV...

If you have a TV that's operated by remote control, it is recommended that you plug it directly into a wall outlet instead of the cable set-top terminal.

1. Turn on your TV.

- 2. Press [TV], then [MUTE] together hold both buttons down until the indicator light illuminates red. 3. a. Press and hold [CH] until your TV turns off. As soon as your TV turns
- off, release [CH ▲] . OR

b.From the TV Setup Code list, locate and enter a 3-digit code for your brand. If multiple codes are listed, you may have to enter several 3-digit codes until your TV turns off.

4. Press [MUTE].

- a.If your TV turns back on, press [TV] to lock in the code. The indicator light will blink and go out.
- b. If your TV does not turn back on, repeat steps 3 and 4 until you can turn your TV on and off ^e.

[●]When using the Point and Press [™] Programming method (step 3a & 4), if you find a code that turns your TV off but not back on, you may have gone past the correct matching code. Try pressing [CH V] one step at a time until you find a code that turns your TV back on.

5. Programming Volume Control

When you first program your remote, volume and mute are controlled through your TV.

To control volume / mute through your CABLE set-top terminal...

1. Press [CBL], then [MUTE] together - hold both down until the indicator light illuminates red.

2. Press [VOL ▲], then [CBL] for CABLE volume. The indicator light will blink and go out.

To return volume control back to your TV, repeat step 1 above, then press [VOL 1], then [TV] in step 2.

6. Code Number Readback

To identify the 3-digit TV setup code stored under the Point and Press[™] method...

1. Press [TV], then [MUTE] together - hold both down until the indicator light illuminates red.

2. Press [INFO] to identify your TV setup code. The indicator light will "blink back" the code numbers, with a 1-second interval between each digit of the code.

Example : For code "035", the indicator light will blink 10 times, then 3 times, then 5 times.

To identify the 3-digit CABLE setup code, press [CBL] then [MUTE] in step 1 above, then press [INFO].

7. Resetting Your Remote

To reset your remote control to its default settings ...

1. Press [CBL], then [MUTE] together - hold both down until the indicator light illuminates red.

2. Press [A], then [A] again. The indicator light will blink and go out.

8. Helpful Tips and Troubleshooting

1. Your remote is equipped with a Point and Press™ Programming label on the back of its case. This will help you quickly program the remote without using codes.

- 2. The indicator light will remain on while the remote is in a programming mode. In the absence of an entry, the light will go out after 45 seconds.
- When locking in your devices, the indicator light will blink and go out.
- 3. When using the Point and Press™ programming method, you may find a code that turns your device off but not back on. If this happens..

a the correct code has not been found. Continue pressing [CH A] until vour devices turn on and off.

- OR
- b.you may have gone past the correct matching code. Try pressing [CH ▼] one step at a time until you find a code that turns your device back on.
- 4. If you have any questions concerning the operation of your Cable set-top terminal, contact your cable operator.
- 5. Time Out If the same button is pressed and held for 45 seconds, your remote control will turn itself off automatically.

This extends battery life should the remote become lodged under or between heavy objects, for example sofa cushions.

9. Using Your Remote Control

Model RT-U27A iPG : Pre-programmed to operate the Motorola DCT® digital and CFT2200 analog set-top terminals (Cable setup code 001). Model RT-U27B iPG : Pre-programmed to operate the Scientific-Atlanta Explorer®, Pioneer Voyager® and Pace 510 digital set-top terminals (Cable setup code 004).

Model RT-U27AB iPG : Preprogrammed to operate the Motorola DCT® (Cable setup code 109).

The operation of each button is as follows :

- [CBL Power] Cable power on / off. [TV Power]
- TV power on / off. [INFO]
- Press to display program information. [0] - [9] - Enter channel numbers.
- [MUTE] - Mute volume.

[EXIT]

- [LAST] - Recall last channel
- [VOL ▲ / ▼] Increase or decrease volume.
- [CH ▲ / ▼] - Increase or decrease channel.
- [GUIDE] - Display Program Guide. (All models)
- [MENU] - Display main menu. (RT-U27A /PG)
- [▲, ▼, ◀, ▶] Navigates through Program Guide, menu.
- Select Program Guide choice. [SELECT]
- (RT-U27AB iPG & RT-U27B iPG)
- [A], [B], [C] - On-screen decision buttons.
 - (RT-U27AB iPG & RT-U27B iPG)
- [OK / SEL] - Select program guide, menu choice (RT-U27A iPG)
- [PPV / LOCK] Displays PPV events CFT2200 (RT-U27A /PG) - Exit Program Guide, menu. (RT-U27A iPG)
