






Photo Frame Overview

The package contents may differ slightly in appearance with the provided images



- 1. Power: Press to turn on or turn off the DPF player.
- 2. Play / Pause: Press to enter / confirm; Press to pause when slideshow pictures and press again to continue slideshow.

3. Navigation button

- Press ◀ to move left (rotate a picture by left 90° when browser mode).
- Press beto move right (rotate a picture by right 90° when browser mode).
- Press \blacktriangle to move the cursor to the previous icon or skip to the previous picture.
- Press ▼ to move the cursor to the next icon or skip to the next picture.
- 4. Menu: Back to last step.
- **5. SD/SDHC:** Insert one of the SD/SDHC cards each time.
- 6. USB: Insert a USB flash stick.
- 7. 5V DC IN: Insert the power adaptor cord to connect the unit with power outlet.

Power Connection







- 1. Connect the power adapter to the DC IN jack on the left side of the frame.
- 2. Plug in the power socket.
- 3. The frame will automatically power on.


Insert a memory card

Insert card in the direction indicated by the arrow on the top of the card (the side of the memory card on which sticker is affixed face the frame).

SD/SDHC card is compatible with this unit.


Aligning the memory card upside down may cause user-error damage.

This may nullify the warranty.



USB Removable Storage Devices

Insert USB removable storage device into the USB port on the side of the frame.



NOTE: This device will read USB first and will not recognise the memory card if you Insert a memory card and extra USB memory together at the same time.

Insert a memory card

Removing the Memory Card

When removing a memory card from the frame, pull the card straight away from the unit. Avoid bending the card.

Select SD card or USB device

On the main menu, press MENU, and select to read SD card or USB device.

Display Photos

Note: The frame will display pictures in the memory card or USB device automatically if there is a memory card or USB device is inserted to the frame before connecting power.

In the main menu, select PHOTO icon and press to play the photos.

Thumbnail Mode

When displaying, press ◀ or ▶to move to previous or next photo, press MENU to enter into Thumbnail Mode.





Rotate a Photo

When displaying images, press the **navigation key** to rotate the displaying photo for 90nce an operation.






Setting


Press " ▲" or "▼" to select the setting item, and press ▶ to confirm.

Select to set slideshow repeatedly or once.



Question	Answer
What is the main function of the digital photo frame?	Using the digital photo frame,you can display images,calender and clock.
What memory card are compatible with the digital photo frame?	The unit can be compatible with SD/SDHC card
Why picture display seems slow?	You are viewing high-resolution pictures,it can take some time to display
Why the unit can't display pictures?	Make sure the pictures are in JPEG format. Make sure you have inserted a card or USB device properly and selected the PHOTO icon in the main menu.
How can I see the photo file list?	Please set display mode of photo to Thumbnail. you can see the photo file list in thumbnail mode.

Troubleshooting

Some simple checks or a minor adjustment eliminate common problems:

No power

- 1. Check the power button is on.
- 2. Check the power outlet is operational.
- 3. Check the power cord is no damanaged.
- 4. Check the power plug is firmly connected to photo frame.

Can not read the card

- 1. Check the card is no damanaged.
- 2. Check the card is connected the photo frame correctly.
- 3. Pull out the card, and then insert again.

Photo Frame is not working

Trun off the power, and then turn it on again.
