

Finding the controls

Main unit (control panel)




- 1 Microphone
- 2 Liquid crystal display
- Memo Message button & indicator records/plays back a voice memo.
 Mute button
- 4 E-Mail button & indicator Pause button
- 5 Speed Dial button
- 6 Auto Answer button
 - —light on: answering device activated.
 - —light off: used as a regular telephone.
- **Replay** button plays back recorded messages. / **Record** button records telephone calls.
- 8 Stop button
- Start/Fax/Copy button starts faxing or copying.
- **Resolution** button selects the resolution when faxing or copying.

- Multi-operation buttons refer to the function displayed on the display panel.
- 12 Redial button
- **Function** button initiates programming.
- Search button searches the directory by pressing the up and down buttons.
 Volume button adjusts ringer, speaker and handset volume by pressing the up and down buttons.
- 15 **Phonebook** button.
- 16 Portable Handset button
- 17 Speakerphone button
- **Tone** button switches to tone dialing.








Installing the ink film


1 Open the control panel.





 - 1 Find the "T" shaped gear (blue).




- 2 Insert the blue core into the right slot of the main unit.
- 3 Insert the "T" shaped gear (blue) into the left slot of the main unit.




4 Insert the white core into the slots shown in the picture below.



5 If the ink film is slack, tighten it by winding the "T" shaped gear.




Installing recording paper (A4 size)

- Install the recording paper tray.
 - 1 Insert the left tab on the recording paper tray into the left slot of the main unit.
 - 2 Insert the right tab into the right slot of the main unit.




2 Insert the recording paper into the recording paper tray.


Open the paper entrance cover until it locks.




- 2 Fan the stack of recording paper (A4 size).

3 Close the paper entrance cover by leaning it back.




4 Install the recording paper cover on the recording paper tray by sliding it down from the top.




Setting up the hand scanner


Press down the knob of the hand scanner, and pull out the hand scanner from the main unit.




2 Slide and open the battery cover by slightly pushing part.



3 Connect the battery to the hand scanner, and close the battery cover.







 The hand scanner battery is charged when the hand scanner is inserted into the main unit.

- The display items of the main unit are somewhat different from that of the portable handset.






Automatic dialing on the main unit

Storing names and telephone numbers in the speed dialer

You can store up to 9 names and telephone numbers which are stored in the phonebook. The dialling buttons ($\widehat{1}$ to $\widehat{9}$) function as memory stations.



- 4 Lift the handset or press (Speakerphone).
- **5** Dial the fax number.
- **6** When a fax tone is heard, press (Fax)
- Replace the handset if you are using it.The unit will start fax transmission.



Sending faxes

Sending a fax using the speed dialer



- Open the document cover, and adjust the width of the document guides to the size of the document.
- 2 Insert the document (up to 5 pages) FACE DOWN until a single beep is heard.
- ${f 3}$ If necessary, press $\stackrel{\text{\tiny mg}}{\bigcirc}$ (Resolution) repeatedly to select the desired setting.
- $\mathbf{4}_{\mathsf{Press}} \overset{\text{\tiny \textit{fig}}}{\bigcirc}$ (Speed dialer).
- $\boldsymbol{5}$ Press memory station number ($\widehat{\boldsymbol{1}}$ to $\widehat{\boldsymbol{9}}$).
- **6** Press \bigcirc
 - The unit will start fax transmission.

Receiving faxes

Receiving a fax manually (AUTO ANSWER off)

Using the main unit:



- When you hear a ring, lift the handset or press (Speakerphone) to answer the call.
- 2 When:
 - document reception is required,
 - a fax calling tone (slow beep) is heard, or
 - no sound is heard,

press $\bigoplus_{0\neq 2}^{\lambda^{6}-1}$ (Fax).

Replace the handset if you are using it.

The unit will start fax reception.

Using the portable handset:




- When you hear a ring, lift the portable handset from the charger to answer the call.
 - If the portable handset is not set on the charger, press (Talk).
- 2 When:
 - -document reception is required,
 - -a fax calling tone (slow beep) is heard, or
 - -no sound is heard,

press $\stackrel{7777}{\textcircled{\circ}}$ (Fax reception).

• The main unit will start fax reception.

Setting ANSWER mode



If the \bigcirc (Auto answer) light is on, turn it off by pressing \bigcirc .

When AUTO ANSWER mode is off, the unit provides two types of receiving modes: "電話優先" (Telephone) mode and "ファクス優先" (Fax/Telephone) mode.

Telephone mode (電話優先) –Pre-selected setting: Select this mode when you plan to answer the calls yourself.

When receiving calls, you have to answer all calls manually.

Fax/Telephone mode (ファクス優先):

Select this mode when you are near the unit and want to use it to receive voice calls yourself and fax calls automatically.

Change the setting if you want to use this mode.




Receiving faxes

Receiving a fax automatically (AUTO ANSWER on)



- If the (Auto answer) light is off, turn it on by pressing ().
- 2 When receiving a call, the unit will receive a fax document or record a voice message automatically depending on the caller's request.

Recording your own greeting




You can record your own greeting message. When receiving a call, it will be played to callers instead of the pre-recorded Japanese greeting message.

Setting AUTO ANSWER mode



AUTO ANSWER mode will work when the (1) (Auto answer) light is on.

AUTO ANSWER mode provides three types of receiving modes: "ファクス / 留守電" (Fax/Answering device) mode, "ファクス専用" (Fax only) mode and "留守電専用" (Answering device only) mode.

Fax/Answering device mode (ファクス / 留守電)

-Pre-selected setting:

Select this mode when you want to receive all voice and fax calls automatically.

Fax only mode (ファクス専用):

Select this mode when you wish to use the unit only as a fax machine.

Answering device only mode (留守電専用):

Select this mode when you wish to use the unit only as a telephone answering device.

Change the setting if you want to use the fax only mode or answering device only mode.






