REPLACING THE BATTERIES

Remove the screw on the battery compartment door (located on the back of your Sports NutTM). Remove the battery compartment door. Remove the old batteries. Insert four (4) AA batteries (we recommend alkaline) with the negative (-) ends against the springs. Replace battery compartment door.

ADULT SUPERVISION IS RECOMMENDED WHEN CHANGING BATTERIES.
