



MODEL H6015 CONTROLS



- A. **INPUT:** Connect your guitar here, using a shielded instrument cable with a 1/4" jack.
- B. **CHANNEL GAIN:** Adjusts the amount of gain in the Drive Channel.
- C. **CHANNEL SWITCH:** This switch allows you to select Clean/Drive Channel.
- D. **3 BAND EQUALIZATION:** The main equalization of the Model H6015 is a classic 3-band passive network. All pass (no band cut) is attained with the controls in the full clockwise position—unlike active controls which exhibit a “flat” setting at the 12 o’clock positions.
- E. **MASTER VOLUME:** This knob controls the pre-gain volume of the amplifier.
- F. **CHANNEL FOOT SWITCH JACK:** Connect a one button foot switch here for remote control of the Clean/Drive Channel.
- G. **HEADPHONES OUTPUT:** For connection to almost any headphone with a 1/4" jack.
- H. **POWER LED:** The power LED illuminates when the power is ON.
- I. **POWER SWITCH:** Turns power ON and OFF.

Caring For Your Amplifier

- DO NOT remove the grounding prong to fit the plug into a two-pronged outlet!
- To keep the amplifier working properly, DO NOT expose it to rain or moisture.
- DO NOT pull or lift the amplifier by the power cord.
- UNPLUG the amplifier before cleaning, and only clean with a damp cloth (no chemicals).
