Intended use

Your Black & Decker Blender has been designed for processing ingredients as listed in this manual.

This appliance is intended for indoor consumer use only.

Safety Instructions

• Warning! When using mains-powered appliances, basic safety precautions, including the following, should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, personal injury and material damage.

• Read all of this manual carefully before using the appliance.

• The intended use is described in this manual. The use of any accessory or attachment or the performance of any operation with this appliance other than those recommended in this instruction manual may present a risk of personal injury.

- Retain this manual for future reference.
- Always route the cord carefully to avoid a tripping hazard.
- Never operate an appliance directly below the socket-outlet it is connected to.

Using your appliance

• Make sure that the appliance is switched off before connecting to or disconnecting from the power supply.

- Always take care when using the appliance.
- Do not use the appliance outdoors.
- Never pull the power supply cord to disconnect the plug from the socket. Keep the power supply cord away from heat, oil and sharp edges.
- Disconnect the appliance from the power supply when not in use, before fitting or removing parts, maintenance and before cleaning.
- Surfaces may be hot during use and during the cool down period
- Do not operate or place any part of this appliance on or near any hot surface, such as a gas or electric burner or in a heated oven.
- When using an extension cord with your appliance, make sure the extension cord is correctly wired & rated for its use.

Safety of others

• Do not allow children or any person unfamiliar with these instructions to use the appliance.

• Do not allow children or animals to come near the work area or to touch the appliance or power supply cord. Close supervision is necessary when the appliance is used near children.

- Never leave an appliance unattended when in use
- Do not allow the cord set to hang over bench tops

After use

• Switch off and remove the plug from the socket before leaving the appliance unattended and before changing, cleaning or inspecting any parts of the appliance.

• When not in use, the appliance should be stored in a dry place. Children should not have access to stored appliances.

Inspection and repairs

- Before use, check the appliance for damaged or defective parts. Check for breakage of parts, damage to switches and any other conditions that may affect its operation.
- Do not use the appliance if any part is damaged or defective.

• Have any damaged or defective parts repaired or replaced by an authorised repair agent.

• Before use, check the power supply cord for signs of damage, ageing and wear.

• Do not use the appliance if the power supply cord or mains plug is damaged or defective.

• If the power supply cord or mains plug is damaged or defective it must be repaired by the manufacturer or its service agent or a similarly qualified person in order to avoid a hazard. Do not cut the power supply cord and do not attempt to repair it yourself.

• Never attempt to remove or replace any parts other than those specified in this manual.

• Do not attempt to repair the appliance. Take it to your nearest Black & Decker-owned or authorised Service Centre for repair.

Double insulation

This appliance is double insulated; therefore no earth wire is required. Always check that the power supply corresponds to the voltage on the rating plate.

Additional safety instructions for Blenders

- Do not immerse the appliance, cord set or plug in liquids
- Always leave sufficient space around the appliance for ventilation
- Keep loose clothing, hair, jewellery, etc. away from moving parts.
- Do not use the unit if you have wet hands or bare feet.
- Care is needed when handling cutting blades, especially when removing the blades from the bowl, emptying the bowl and during cleaning.

• Switch off the appliance before changing accessories or approaching parts which move in use.

Assembly

This appliance requires some assembly to complete the required task. Please refer to the relevant section for particular assembly details.

All parts should be cleaned before use. See "Cleaning" for details.

Use

As a Blender

Place the appliance on a clean, flat work surface

Place the jar onto the motor base and rotate it in a clockwise direction until it locks in position.

Add the ingredients to the jar then fit the lid and filler cap. The filler cap must be rotated clockwise until it locks in place.

Note: Do not exeed the maximum capacity of 1.5 litres.

Connect the appliance to a suitable electrical supply. Rotate the switch to the required speed setting. The switch can also be rotated to the Pulse position to give greater control.

When blending is complete, either release the switch lever so it can return from the pulse position or return the rotary lever to the Off position. Once the blades have come to a complete stop, rotate the jar in an anti- clockwise direction and lift the jar from the motor housing. Rotate the filler cap anticlockwise and lift it from the jar before removing the lid. Pour the ingredients into a suitable container.

Note: Ingredients can be added to the jug while the lid is off, or by inserting them through the hole left when the filler cap (1) is removed.

Note: The Blender will not operate unless the lid is correctly fitted.

The Blender should not run for longer than 1 minute. After each minute's use, the Blender should be allowed to cool for at least 3 minutes. This can be repeated 3 times before further use, the unit must be left to cool to room temperature.

Note: The motor is equipped with an auto resetting thermostat. This may operate and stop blending if the appliance is overloaded. If this should happen, allow the Blender to cool down and remove some of the contents of the jar. The thermostat will take a few minutes to re-set.

As a Coffee Grinder (BX360 & BX375)

Remove the cover (13) from the coffee grinding attachment (11) by holding the cup & rotating the cover in an anti-clockwise direction. Add a maximum of 40g of coffee beans to the cup. Place the cover on the cup & rotate it clockwise until it locks in place. Position the assembly on the motor housing (6), rotating it clockwise until it locks into place. Press the required speed button (8) & allow the grinder to operate.

Note: The Coffee Grinder should not be run for longer than 20 seconds. After each 20 second's use, the Coffee Grinder must be allowed to cool down for at least 3 minutes. This can be repeated 3 times before further use, the unit must be left to cool to room temperature.

As a Cheese Grater (BX375 Only)

Cheese should be cut into 15mm cubes before grinding. Remove the cover (14) from the cheese grating attachment (12) by holding the cup & rotating the cover in an anticlockwise direction. Add the prepared cheese to the cup. Place the cover on the cup & rotate it clockwise until it locks in place. Position the assembly on the motor housing (6), rotating it clockwise until it locks into place. Press the required speed button (8) & allow the grater to operate.

Note: The Cheese Grater should not be run for longer than 20 seconds. After each 20 second's use, the Cheese Grater must be allowed to cool down for at least 3 minutes. This can be repeated 3 times before further use, the unit must be left to cool to room temperature.

Do not operate the appliance continuously for more than 1 minute . After operating continuously for 1 minute , let it cool down for at least 3 minutes before operating it again.

Maintenance

Your Black & Decker tool has been designed to operate over a long period of time with a minimum of maintenance. Continuous satisfactory operation depends upon proper tool care and regular cleaning.

Warning! Before performing any maintenance or cleaning of the tool, disconnect the appliance from the power supply.

Ventilation slots should be cleaned occasionally with a clean, dry paint brush.

Cleaning

The motor housing should be cleaned with a clean damp cloth only.

The jar & grinding attachments can be washed in warm soapy water. Rinse with clean water and dry thoroughly with a dry soft cloth.

Note: Do not use abrasives or chemical cleaners on any part of this appliance.

Note: Take care when handling the blades, they are sharp & cannot be dismantled.
