


# INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

# SINGLE CONTROL KITCHEN FAUCET

With Spray in Escutcheon





Use this diagram to familiarize yourself with the various parts of thefaucet assembly. Make sure you have all the illustrated parts before you begin installation.

If you are putting in a new sink, it is easier to mount the faucet, drain and any other accessories **before** installing the sink into the countertop.

- Observe all local plumbing codes.
- Carefully inspect the valve parts for any damage.
- Flush all piping thoroughly before installing.
- Shut off hot & cold water supplies.
- Do not use plumber's putty or thread sealants on mounting nuts or coupling nuts.


## Remove old faucet



1 Turn off both water



1 Pass spray hose down through hole in escutcheon and extreme right sink deck hole and up through center sink deck hole. Attach spray



2 Place a bead of plumber's putty around base of faucet. Insert shanks into sink deck holes with spout to front over sink.




3 Thread mounting nuts onto shanks. FINGER tighten securely.

4 Connect hot and cold

tubes with coupling nuts.

FINGER tighten securely.




Flush lines

1 Turn on water supplies and check for leaks. With faucet off remove aerator, turn on water rotating hot through cold to flush lines and faucet. Turn faucet off and replace aerator.


Sterling will, at its election, repair or replace a faucet where Sterling's inspection discloses any such defects occurring in normal residential usage.


