Inserting batteries to the right poles (+, -) and push-close the cover in the direction the arrow is indicating


Notice : It will be the cause of damage if too much weight is pressed on the cover.

Listening to Music with yepp

First, insert batteries and connect the earphones to the player.


Playing Music (Power On)

When you press the ►/■ button, the yepp logo appears and a music/voice file/FM is played.



Stopping Music (Power Off/Sleep)

When you press the ►/■ button while playing, the music stops.
If any key is not entered, it automatically turns into Power Off or Sleep mode in 5 seconds.



Setting up Volume / Hold Functions

Adjusting the Volume

Press the ⊕ / ⊖ button on the front adjust the volume while playing.



Note : Volume ranges from 00 to 30.
● Press short to adjust step by step.
● Press long to adjust continuously.


HOLD Function

Press the (MODE) key longer and choose 3. Hold in the MENU mode → 1. Choose the Confirm. But, press the ►/■ button longer (1 second or more) to set HOLD while voice recording)




Notice : Under Hold mode, no key works.
Press the ►/■ button longer (more than 1 second) in the HOLD mode to release.

Changing Modes




Changing to Voice Mode

Stop playing music and press the **MODE** button short to change to voice mode. Press the **▶/■** button to play.




Changing to Music Mode

Stop playing voice and press the **MODE** button short twice to change to music mode. Press the **▶/■** button to play.



Changing to FM Mode

To listen to the FM radio, stop the playback of voice and press the **MODE** button short once again.




Recording Voice

To Record Voice

- 1 Press the **REC** button longer (more than 1 second) to start a voice recording.
- 2 Press the **▶/■** button to pause while recording. Press the **▶/■** button again to resume recording.
- 3 Press the **REC** button to stop recording. A new voice file is created.

Notice : Recording is done in the order of VI001,VI002....

- When memory is full, recording stops automatically. (The available time is displayed on the right from the center when recording begins.)
- Music mode is switched to voice mode after voice recording stop.
- When recording voice, make sure to record it for longer than 5 seconds. (Recording is not available in case of less than 5 seconds.)
- It is recommended to keep the unit 10cm away from you in case of voice recording (If not, the recording quality might be inferior)



Searching for Music/Voice Files


Searching for Specific Parts in a Track (Music/Voice file)

- Press the ◀◀ / ▶▶ button for longer while playing to find and listen to the part you choose. Release the ◀◀ / ▶▶ button to resume playing.




Searching for Music/Voice Files in Play

- Press the ▶▶ button short while playing to play the next track.
- Press the ◀◀ button short within 5 seconds from the start to play the previous track. Press the ◀◀ button short after 5 seconds from the start to play the beginning of the current track.



Searching for Music/Voice Files in Stop

- Press the ◀◀ / ▶▶ button in STOP mode to skip to the previous or next track. Press the ▶/■ button to play.




- Note :**
- With VBR files, pressing the ◀◀ button within 5 seconds from the start may not result in playing the previous track.
 - With VBR files, the actual running time may differ from that of the player display.
 - VBR(Variable Bit Rate) file: MP3 file whose compression rate changes when played.

Listening to FM

FM On / Off

Press the **▶/■** button during FM reception to turn the radio Off, and repress it to turn On.



Changing the FM Channels

Press the **▶/■** button short during FM reception to move to the previous/next channel.




Changing channel frequency

Press the **◀◀ / ▶▶** button longer from the channel desired to change frequency for Auto Search. Press the **◀◀ / ▶▶** short during flickering 'Ch' to select a desired frequency and then press the **▶/■** button longer to store the appropriate frequency.



Automatically storing frequency

Press the **◀◀ / ▶▶** button longer during the FM reception and then press the button short during flicking 'Ch' (press the button longer once more to cancel the setting) to search frequencies automatically and to store them in 10 channels respectively (Auto Search).



Note : If you press the **▶/■** button during Auto Search, it will be switched to the modes storing the channel searched and of manual search for the channel currently being searched.

Notice : yepp Audio Manager is not supported in the FM mode.
To use the yepp Audio Manager in the FM mode, switch to the Music mode or Voice mode.

Loop Repeating

Loop Function

Starting Point

While playing music/voice files, press the **MODE** button short at the first part that you want to set up the loop.

-  flickers in the display.



Ending Point

Press the **MODE** button short at the last point of the loop.


-  appears in the display screen.
- The loop is repeatedly played.



Note : Press the **MODE** button short to cancel the loop.

Setting up MENU

- Press the **MODE** button longer than 1 seconds to switch to **MENU** mode.
- Use the /  button to select and the /  button to move.
- Press the **MODE** button one more time to cancel the **MENU** mode.




- **Play mode** : To select track repeating mode.
- **Equalizer** : To use equalizer function
- **Hold** : To set the Hold function(Press the /  button for more than 1 second in the play or stop mode to release it.)
- **Setting** : To change the basic setup options of the display.
- **File** : To delete or format music/voice files.
- **Exit menu** : To exit **MENU**

Note : ● In **MENU**, **Go up** can be used to exit the current setting.
● In **MENU** mode, no input for 15 seconds will cancel the mode.

Repeating Tracks

Track Repeating Function

- 1 In **MENU**, select **1.Play mode**.
- 2 In **PLAY MODE**, use the ◀◀/▶▶ button to move to the mode you want and press the ▶/■ button to select.




- **Normal**: To play all the tracks in order one time.
- **Repeat one**: To repeat one track.
- **Repeat all**: To repeat all tracks.
- **Shuffle**: To play tracks at random.
- **Intro**: To play the first 10 seconds of tracks.

Setting up EQ

EQ Function

- 1 In **MENU**, select **2. Equalizer**.
- 2 In **EQ**, use the ◀◀/▶▶ button to move to the tone you want (out of the 5 tones) and press the ▶/■ button to select.



Note : You can adjust Bass and Treble in the USER mode.


Deleting

- 1 In **MENU**, select **5. File**
- 2 In **File**, select **Delete** and the mode the target file is in.
- 3 Move to the file to delete and press the **▶/■** button to select. The file is deleted.
- 4 Select **Cancel** to exit the mode.



Formatting

- 1 In **MENU**, select **5. File**
- 2 In **File**, select **Format** → **Confirm**. Select **Cancel** to exit the mode.






Installing Software (PC)

Insert the installation CD into CD-ROM drive.
Then the picture appears as shown below.

1 Select [yapp Audio Manager] →
[yapp Audio Manager Install].



2 Click [Next] for a series of windows that appear.



3 Before using yapp Audio Manager, make sure to set up options (refer to p.39)

Note : How to delete the yapp Audio Manager (Rioport Manager):

- [Start] → [Control Panel] → [Add or Remove Programs] → Select the yapp Audio Manager (Rioport Manager) → [Change/Remove] → [OK]
- If yapp Audio Manager (Rioport Manager) is already installed on your PC, remove the existing yapp Audio Manager (Rioport Manager) first before making a new installation.

Installing Software (Mac)

To install the Mac iTunes Plug-in, iTunes 1.1 version or more should be installed in your system. If you have installed by using the Mac OS 9 installation CD or Mac OS X installation CD, the system is basically installed. If not, download it from iTunes homepage of Apple Computer (<http://www.apple.com/itunes>) to install.





- Before connecting to the computer, make sure to install yepp Audio Manager. If "Add New Hardware Wizard" appears, press the [Cancel] button and install yepp Audio Manager.
- If USB driver is not installed automatically, refer to page 34.

Note : It might make computer go to temporary malfunction when you unplug the USB cable from computer while yepp Audio Manager is initiating yepp or executing command.





Note :

How to check USB driver

"Turning on the power of yepp" → "Connecting yepp to PC"
- USB driver is installed with the message saying that it is searching for a new device.

If USB driver is not installed, try one more time after rebooting the PC. (If USB driver is not installed at the second attempt, contact your PC manufacturer.)

When USB driver is installed, "SAMSUNG YP-90" will appear in [System Properties] → [Device Manager] as shown in the picture on the right.



CD Ripping Settings

- Click on the yepp Audio Manager → [View] → [Options...] → [Read CD] → Set the [Record File As] → Set the [Bit Rate] → Press [OK]



Make MP3 files from an Audio CD (PC)

Make sure to install yepp Audio Manager on PC before making an MP3 file.
You can make MP3 files through yepp Audio Manager.

- 1 Run yepp Audio Manager.
 - Double-click yepp Audio Manager icon on your desktop.
- 2 Insert the audio CD into the CD-ROM drive.
 - Press the **[read a CD]** button to see CD information.
- 3 Check songs to convert into an MP3 file.



- 4 Press the **[Start Reading]** button.
 - Conversion status is indicated on the right bottom of the window while the file is converted.



- 5 File converting status will be displayed.
 - **[Options]** function should be set first to select the file format. (refer to P.38)



Note : The stored file can be found in the Track Directory, which is set **[View] → [Options...] → [Storage]**.

Rearranging Files (PC)

You can change the order that the files are played.

- 1 Run yepp Audio Manager.
 - Double-click yepp Audio Manager icon on your desktop.

- 2 Select the file to rearrange.

Changing a File Name (Mac)

Before changing a file name, execute iTunes.
Connect yepp to Mac, turn on the power of yepp and then proceed.



The buttons do not work.

- Check to see if HOLD switch is set for HOLD.

In Playback mode, music is not played after pressing the Play button

- Check to see if Music files are saved in the built-in memory.

Music files cannot be downloaded.

- Check to see if the driver is installed rightly in the computer.
- Check the connection between yepp and computer.

Backlight does not work.

- Check the backlight setup.
- When the remained voltage is low, the backlight would not be on longer.

yepp keeps being turned off.

- In Stop mode, the power is automatically turned off after five seconds.
- Check to see if there are files saved in it.

Something's wrong with play time displayed during Play mode.

- Check to see if it is playing VBR(Variable Bit Rate) files. VBR files are supported partly.

LCD window is dark

- Check Contrast

Strange letters are displayed

- Check the font set up.

5. The warranty is not applicable in cases other than defects in material, design and workmanship. The warranty does not cover the following:

- ◆ Periodic checks, maintenance, repair and replacement of parts due to normal wear and tear.
- ◆ Abuse or misuse, including but not solely limited to the failure to use this product for its normal purpose or in accordance with Samsung's instructions usage and maintenance.
- ◆ The product has been used in conjunction with accessories not approved by Samsung for use with this product.
- ◆ Failure of the product arising from incorrect installation or use not consistent with technical or safety standards in current force, or failure to comply with product manual instructions.
- ◆ Accidents, Acts of God or any cause beyond the control of Samsung caused by lightning, water, fire, public disturbances and improper ventilation.

- ◆ Unauthorized modifications carried out for the product to comply with local or national technical standards in countries for which the Samsung product was not originally designed.
 - ◆ Repairs performed by non-authorized service centers such as opening of the product by a non-authorized person.
 - ◆ The model, serial No. and product number on the product has been altered, deleted, removed or made illegible.
6. This warranty does not affect the consumers statutory rights nor the consumers rights against the dealer from their purchase/sales agreement.

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
