

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


CERAMIC SINGLE CONTROL KITCHEN FAUCET with or without Spray



Use this diagram to familiarize yourself with the various parts of the faucet assembly. Make sure you have all the illustrated parts before you begin installation.

If you are putting in a new sink, it is easier to mount the faucet, drain and any other accessories *before* installing the sink into the countertop.

- Observe all local plumbing codes.
- Carefully inspect the valve parts for any damage.
- Flush all piping thoroughly before installing.
- Shut off hot & cold water supplies.
- Do not use plumber's putty or thread sealants on mounting nuts or coupling nuts.


SINGLE CONTROL KITCHEN FAUCET


1 Phillips and crescent wrench

Remove old faucet




Turn off both water supplies.

Install faucet




1 Insert hose guide in far right hole in sink. Thread mounting nut onto hose guide shank. FINGER tighten.

Flush lines




4 Place a bead of plumber's putty around base of faucet. Insert shank into holes in sink with spout to front over sink.



1 Turn on water supplies and check for leaks. With faucet off remove aerator, turn on water rotating hot through cold to flush lines and faucet. Turn faucet off and replace aerator.

OPTIONAL MATERIALS:


- · Supply stops (2) Some installations may require stops to be installed.
- · Supply tubing (2) and fittings will need to be provided.

3 Basin wrench for


removing old faucet.



2 Disconnect supply lines.

3 Remove mounting nuts,

lift off faucet.




2 Insert spray hose down through hose duide and up through center hole in sink.

3 Position putty plate.


Attach spray hose to spray

outlet, by rotating faucet body.


Tighten securely with wrench.



5 Thread mounting nuts on hot and cold supply shanks. FNGER tighten securely.



6 Connect hot & cold supply lines onto faucet



shanks with couopling nuts. FINGER tighten securely.
