



GROUNDING INSTRUCTIONS

This product must be grounded. If it should malfunction or breakdown, grounding provides a path of least resistance for electric current to reduce the risk of electric shock. This product is equipped with a cord having an equipment – grounding conductor and a grounding plug. The plug must be plugged into an appropriate outlet that is properly installed and grounded in accordance with all local codes and ordinances.




DANGER

Check with a qualified electrician or service personnel if you are in doubt as to whether the outlet is properly grounded. Do not modify the plug provided with the product. If it does not fit the outlet, have a proper outlet installed by a qualified electrician. Do not use any type of adaptor with this product.

GROUND FAULT CIRCUIT INTERRUPTER (GFCI) PROTECTION

This unit is provided with a ground fault circuit interrupter (GFCI) built into the plug of the power supply cord. This device provides additional protection from the risk of electric shock. **SHOULD REPLACEMENT OF THE PLUG OR CORD BECOME NECESSARY, USE ONLY IDENTICAL REPLACEMENT PARTS THAT INCLUDE ARC PROTECTION.**

ASSEMBLY



MAKE SURE THE HEATER PANELS ARE FOLDED DOWN BEFORE MOUNTING THE HEATER ON THE UMBRELLA.

1. Remove the heater brace from the heater body by sliding it downward. (Fig. 1)


2. Place the heater onto an umbrella pole between 1 inch (25mm) – 2 inches (48mm) in diameter by inserting the pole into the slot. (Fig. 2)

3. Place the heater brace back on by sliding it upward. (Fig. 3)

4. Secure the heater to the umbrella pole by turning the tightening screw clockwise until the heater is secure on the umbrella pole.

5. Using the wire loop at the end of the heater panel, pull the heater panel up until a click is heard. This means that the panel is now locked into position.

NOTE: DO NOT FOLD THE PANELS DOWN WITHOUT FIRST PUSHING THE LOCKING PIN IN.




6. To fold any of the panels down, press the metal locking pin at the hinge of the heater panel, then holding onto the wire loop at the front end of the heater, fold the heater panel down.


NOTE: WAIT UNTIL THE HEATER PANELS HAVE ALL COOLED DOWN BEFORE FOLDING THE HEATER PANELS DOWN.

7. When any of the heater panels are folded down while the unit is on, that panel will shut-off, because on the back of the panel is a shut-off switch so that only two or even one heater panel can be used instead of all three panels.

OPERATION INSTRUCTIO

1. Connect the plug to a 120V/60Hz outlet.
2. Press the Toggle switch on the unit with the "●" for 500W of heat. Only one heater panel will activate. Press the "●●" toggle switch only and two heater panels will activate producing 1000W of heat. Press the two toggle switches together to produce 1500W of heat.
3. To turn off the heater, press both toggle switches downward.

REMEMBER, portable electric heaters are designed for spot heating or as a supplementary heat source. They are not intended to be the main source of heat during the cold months.

Overheat protection shut –off

If an overheat temperature is reached, the heater will automatically shut off.

It can only resume operation when the user resets the unit. Inspect and remove any objects on or adjacent to the heater that may cause high temperature.

To reset the heater:

1. Turn the heater off.
2. Unplug the heater.
3. After 5-10 minutes, plug the unit in again and operate normally.

Caution: You must always take care that there is sufficient distance for safety (at least 3 ft/50cm) between the apparatus and the wall or other objects or combustible materials.

Avoid the use of an extension cord. However, if you must use an extension cord, the cord should be NO.14 AWG minimum size and rated not less than 1875 W

FOR YOUR SAFETY

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

ONLY USE THE UNIT ON A SECURED VERTICAL POLE THAT IS FIRMLY IN PLACE.

1. READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE OPERATING THIS HEATER.
2. This heater is not intended for use in bathrooms, laundry areas or similar indoor locations where there may be moisture. Never place heater where it may fall into a bathtub, swimming pool, or other water receptacle.

3. This unit is intended for household use only. DO NOT use the unit in such areas as construction sites, greenhouses, barns or stables or any place that has flammable materials.
4. DO NOT use the unit without a supporting pole.
5. A heater has hot, arcing or sparking parts inside. Do not use it in areas where gasoline, paint or flammable liquids are used or stored.
6. DO NOT move the unit when still connected to an electrical outlet.
7. Always wait for the unit to cool down before moving, cleaning and storing.
8. DO NOT touch the front of the heater when in use. Please use the tabs at the ends of the unit to fold the panel inward.
9. Extreme caution is necessary when any heater is used near a child or the physically disabled.
10. ALWAYS UNPLUG HEATER WHEN NOT IN USE.
11. DO NOT LEAVE THE UNIT UNATTENDED WHEN IN OPERATION.
12. The unit must have a clearance of 71" from the bottom of the unit to the floor and 12" from the top of the unit to the umbrella.
13. This heater is hot when in use. To avoid burns, do not let bare skin touch hot surfaces. If provided, use handles when moving this heater. Keep combustible materials, such as furniture, pillows, bedding, papers, clothes and curtains at least 3 feet from the front of this heater.
14. DO NOT cover the unit with any type of cloth while in operation or a short time after turning the unit off.
15. DO NOT wrap the power cord around the unit.
16. Do not insert or allow foreign objects to enter any ventilation or exhaust opening as this may cause electric shock, fire or damage to the heater.
17. PLEASE HANDLE THE UNIT WITH CARE.
18. DO NOT operate any unit with a damaged power cord or plug or after the heater malfunctions or if it has been dropped or damaged in any manner.
19. DO NOT USE THE UNIT AS A ROOM HEATER.
20. Do not run power cord under carpet; do not cover cord with throw rugs, runners or the like. Arrange cord away from traffic area where it may be tipped over.
21. To disconnect heater, turn controls to off, then remove plug from outlet.
22. To prevent possible fire, do not block air intakes or exhaust openings in any manner. Do not use on soft surfaces, like a bed, where openings may become blocked.
23. Use this heater only as described in this manual. Any other use not recommended by the manufacturer may cause fire, electric shock or injury to persons and property.
24. The heater is not intended for use with an extension cord. Plug the cord directly into an appropriate wall receptacle. If an extension cord is used, it must be a minimum 14AWG and rated not less than 1875 watts.
25. The output of this heater may vary and its temperature may become intense enough to burn exposed skin. Use of this heater is not recommended for persons with sensitivity to heat or an inability to react to avoid burns.

SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

CLEANING AND STORAGE

1. Turn the unit OFF and unplug the unit before cleaning.
2. Use only a soft cloth to clean the exterior.
3. Cleaner can be used to clean the interior.
4. Do not immerse the unit in water and never allow water to drip into the motor housing.

Caution: Do not allow water to run into the interior or the heater as this could create a fire or electric shock hazard.
