

Care Instructions

Congratulations on your purchase of the Mission Style Ceramic Tile Rim Firepit. It includes a durable, powder coated iron bowl, powder coated steel base, and a decorative tile rim. Be sure to carefully read ALL safety instructions before using your new firepit.

The powder coating on the fire screen will break down over time as the fire pit is burned. We recommend the use of a high heat black spray paint will help to inhibit the process.

You don't need to season your firepit before burning. You may burn wood, synthetic logs or charcoal in your firepit. Pinon wood is ideal because it emits a pleasing aroma that also repels insects. We recommend a mixture of pinon chunks with other woods to achieve a pleasant burning experience.

Some woods tend to crackle and spark more than others. Wind can also blow burning embers around the firepit. In order to safeguard against blowing sparks/embers, make sure you have the screen securely in place while using your firepit.

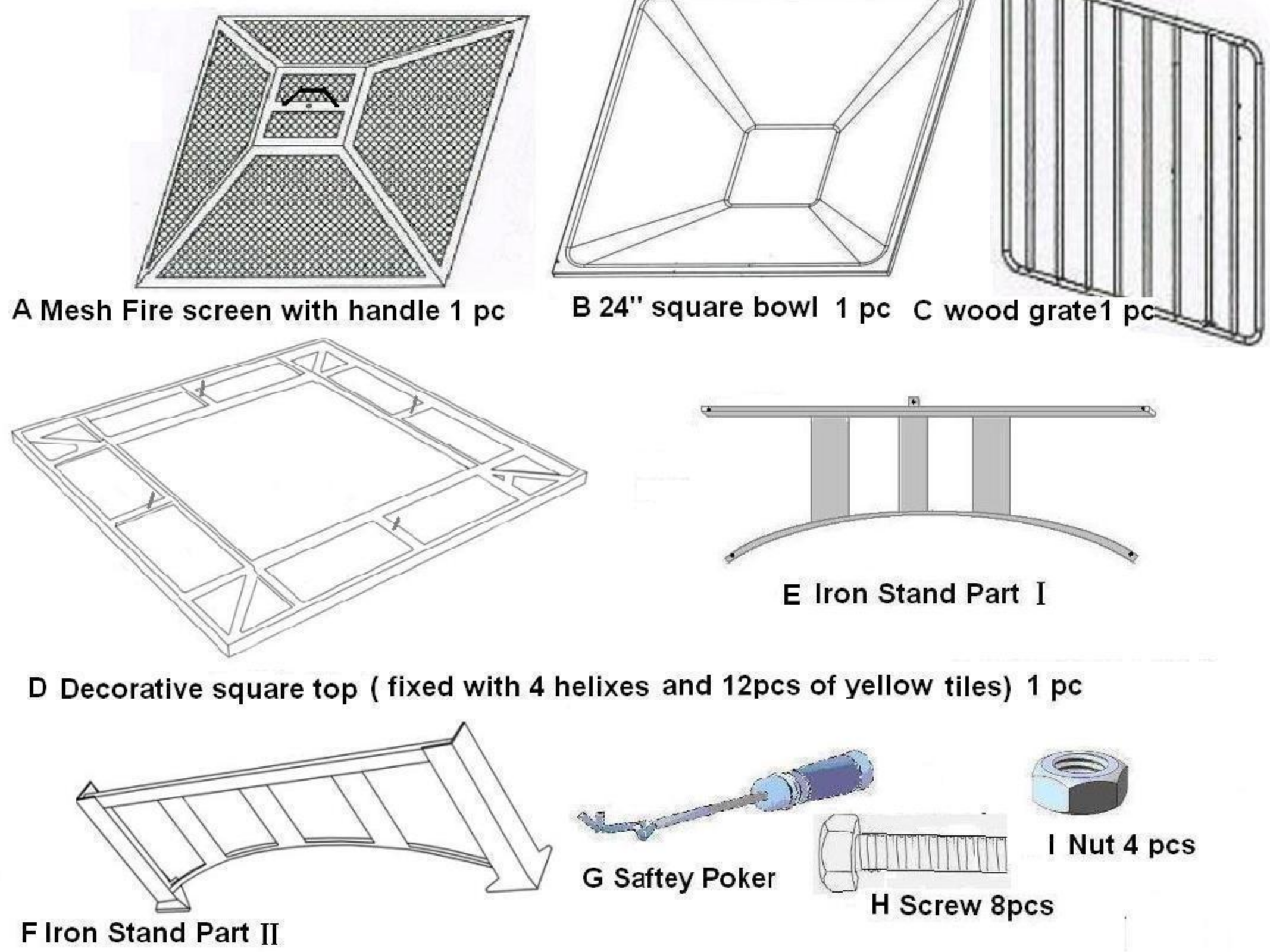

A. Parts List



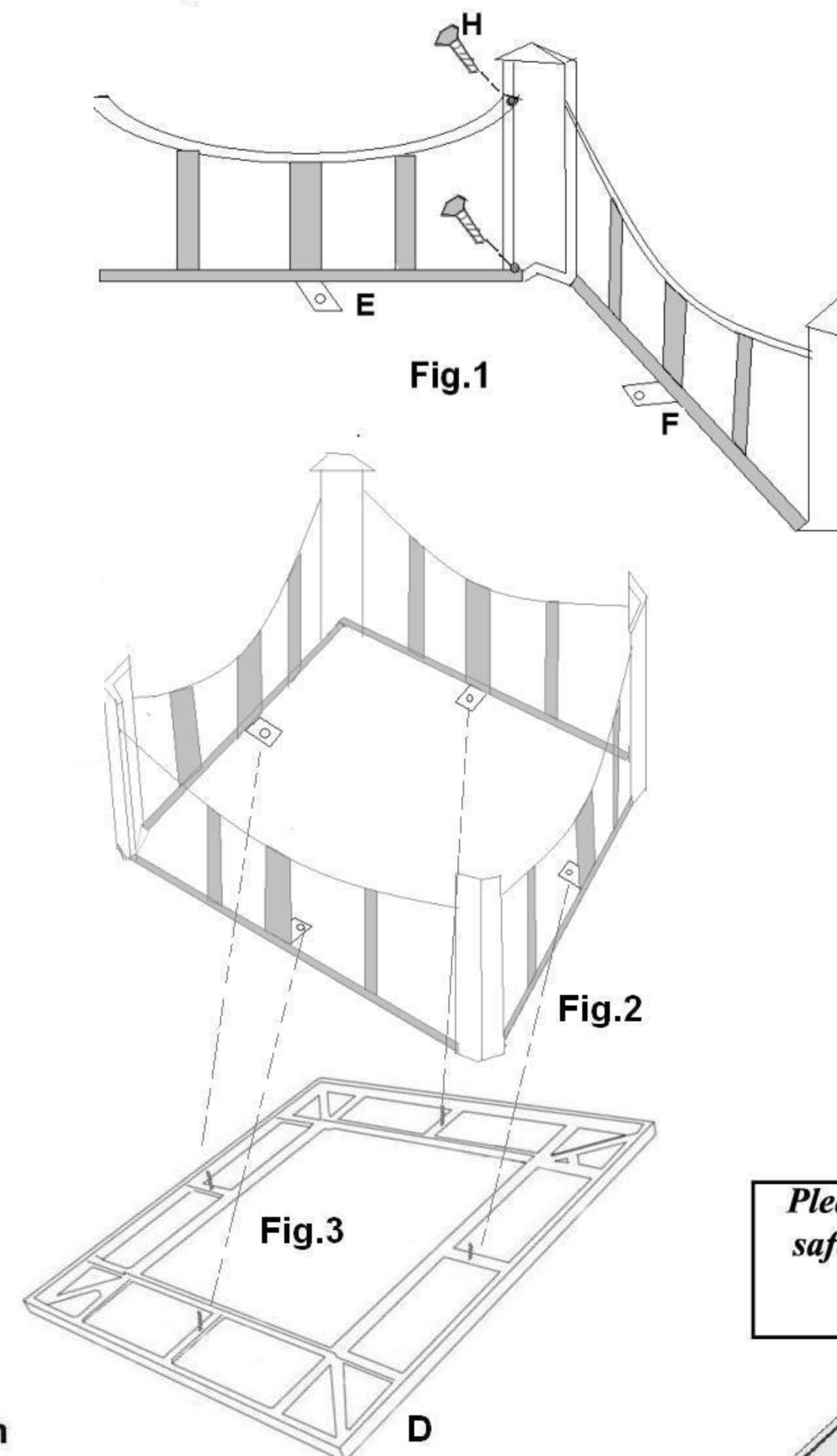
**** Note:** Bag of ordinary SAND required (but not included) to create a 1-2" layer in lower housing body. Tools you'll need: a phillips screwdriver.

B. Assembly Instruction

- STEP 1: Unpack parts carefully and set aside on a flat, non-abrasive surface .
- STEP 2: Choose a level location for set up.
- STEP 3: Connect Iron Stand Part I (E) to Iron Stand Part II (F) using screws (H) as per Fig.1 and Fig.2 .
- STEP 4: Put decorative square top(D) on something soft and flat (cardboard etc.),with yellow side down. Connect stand (E&F) to decorative top(D) by fixing nuts(I) and helixes of the top(D) Fig.3.
- STEP 5 :Turn over the entire assembly and make sure it is level with the floor . Place fire bowl (B) into assembled stand(E&F&D). Place 1-2"thick layer of sand into bottom of the bowl.
- STEP 6: Place wood grate (C) into the bowl (B).Make sure there is at least 1"space between the surface of the sand and the grate.
- STEP 7: Place mesh screen (A) on the top of the bowl (B).

CAUTION: NEVER USE YOUR HANDS TO OPEN OR CLOSE THE MESH SCREEN WHEN HOT, USE THE LIFT TOOL PROVIDED (H).

Your fire pit is now ready for use.



Safety First !!



- * Do NOT leave open flames or embers unattended!
- * Do NOT allow children to be near open flames & fireplace
- * Do NOT burn EXCESSIVELY HOT fires!
- * Do NOT use during windy periods!
- * ALL METAL SURFACES WILL BE VERY HOT WHEN IN USE - DO NOT TOUCH!

Warning: For OUTDOOR USE only

This is an outdoor patio firepit and should be placed in a safe, uncovered location away from combustible materials on all sides of the product.

- * Do NOT use within 4 feet of any combustible materials or walls.
- * Do NOT use in an enclosed, or covered location, or under tree branches
- * The Spark Arrester, fire screen MUST be in place at ALL times during use.
- * Use heat resistant gloves & lift tool when removing fire screen dome
- * Always use the wrought iron stand provided when using the fireplace. NEVER place directly onto a wood floor/deck, near a wood fence or materials.
- * If used over a wood deck, place a non-combustible material such as concrete pavers, stove-mat or hearth board directly beneath the fireplace to catch sparks & embers as well as protect the deck surface.
- * Do not use flammable liquids, large amounts of wood pellets and/or multiple firelogs in the chiminea/fireplace which could produce extremely hot fires.
- * Make sure there is plenty of ventilation completely surrounding the fireplace.
- * **Keep your fires reasonable.** A fire that is too large or too hot can be very dangerous and could damage your fireplace.
- * Although your firepit is considered a closed system , always comply with all local laws, ordinances & statutes restricting the use of outdoor open flames in your community. Consult your local fire department.
- * Always ensure that the fire is completely out before leaving your fireplace unattended. Smother any remaining embers with sand or water.

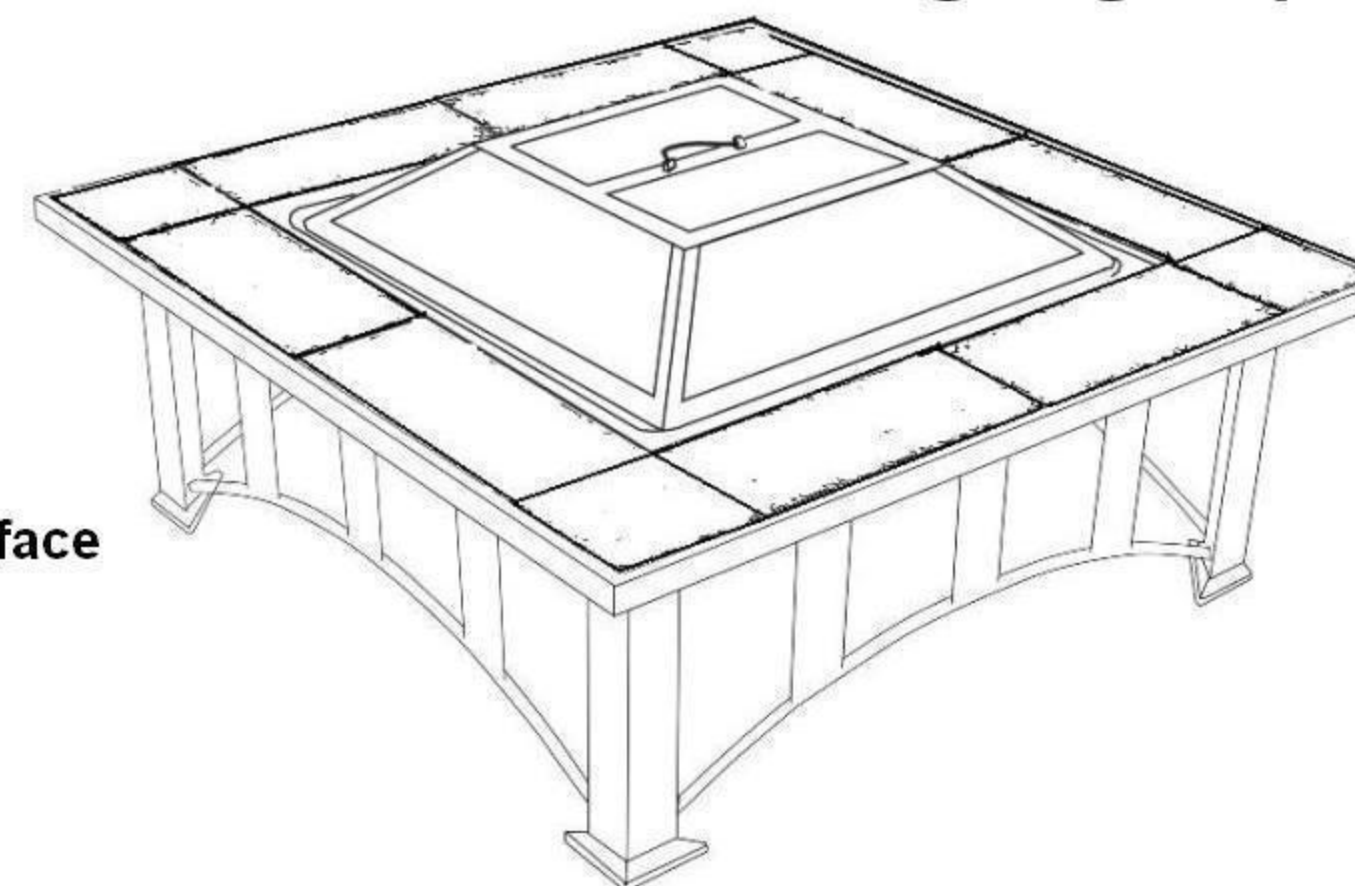
Please use caution and common sense when burning in your firepit. Failure to adhere to the safety guidelines could result in fire damage to your deck, home or yard. Failure to exercise caution could also cause bodily injury or even death - so please be careful!

Fire screen - spark arrester dome MUST be in place at ALL times during use.

Lighting & Operating

- * **BEFORE you ignite your first fire -** In order to properly dissipate heat generated in the base bowl and surrounding floor area, a 1-2" layer of ordinary sand **MUST BE ADDED** to the bottom of the fire bowl. Make sure there is air space of at least 1" between the surface of the sand and the steel grate.
- * Place wood (no more than 3 large log pieces at a time), or firelog (no more than 1 at a time) in the center of the metal grate allowing for air flow between pieces and fireplace walls.
- * Use matches, butane lighters or electric starters. **Do NOT use gasoline, kerosene, starter fluids or other flammable liquids** that might cause a flash, high heat ignition fire.
- * Check and remove ash build up in the base bowl regularly.

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
